ROGATION DAYS were traditionally celebrated on the three days before the solemnity of the Ascension, which will be observed this year on May 25<sup>th</sup> (and celebrated on the weekend of May 27-28<sup>th</sup>. # Concession of Plenary Indulgence

In order to worthily celebrate the hundredth anniversary of the Apparitions of Fatima, by the mandate of Pope Francis, it is granted a Jubilee Year, with the inherent plenary indulgence, from the 27th November 2016 to the 26th November 2017. The plenary indulgence of the jubilee is granted:

- a) to the faithful who visit the Shrine of Fatima in pilgrimage and devotedly participate in a celebration or prayer in honour of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the symbol of faith (Creed) and invoke Our Lady of Fatima;
- b) to the pious faithful who visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in any temple, oratory or adequate place, during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions (the 13th of each month, from May to October 2017), and devotedly participate there in any celebration or prayer in honour of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the symbol of faith (Creed) and invoke Our Lady of Fatima;
- c) to the faithful who, due to their age, disease or other serious reason, are impeded of moving, if, repentant of all their sins and having the firm intention of performing, as soon as possible, the three conditions mentioned bellow, in front of a small image of Our Lady of Fatima, spiritually unite in the days of the apparitions to the jubilee celebrations, offering with trust to God all-merciful through Mary their prayers and pains, or the sacrifices of their own lives.

To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful, truly penitent and animated with charity, must ritually fulfill the following conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

# St. Mary's Circle #75 Daughters of Isabella Celebrating One Hundred Years of Unity – Friendship – Charity

October 1917 - October 2017

In celebration of the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Daughters of Isabella, the chapter will be sharing our history with the parish. We will be sharing in 10 year increments, beginning with October 1917. We hope you will enjoy reading about our rich heritage and our love of and dedication to our Church

### Chapter Five - 1958-67

A local philanthropic outreach was given a new look in 1960. D of I had a tradition of giving a toy to every child who was in the hospital. And now the group needed a new cabinet for the toys. Plans were brought to the meeting for the new toy chest, and the most favorable one was the larger one. It would have a glass door and a drawer at the bottom for magazines. Marcus Sisson said that one could be built in light birch for \$40.00 or from plywood for \$32.99. His bid was accepted, and the cabinet was built and used for many years. A plaque was made for the toy box by Arthur Taylor, and a tag showing the toy was given by D of I was placed on each toy.

It took many fund raisers to make money for philanthropy such as this, and some fundraisers in the 50's and 60's included card parties, bake sales, selling pepper and vanilla, and selling greeting cards. A new idea – a smorgasbord – was also on the agenda. Mary Miller was the first chairman, and before this November 8 (1965) event, she moved all her cooking equipment to the K of C. Various committees began the cooking process in the K of C kitchen, as everything for the Smorgasbord was home cooked. The Smorgasbord was a huge success, and proceeds went to the three local high school scholarships and provided \$100 for each school. (Over the years, the success of the Smorgasbord raised the amount of the scholarship to \$500 for each of the local high schools. The last Smorgasbord was held in 2013.)

In 1966, another long standing tradition began. It started with a barbeque dinner and carry-out at the Knights of Columbus Hall. The sandwich was a huge success, and a big profit was realized from the dinner and raffle. Since the sandwich was such a hit, it was decided that maybe the group could have a booth at the Decatur County Fair. It seemed like a great way to raise money for the various charities. The first official Smorgasbord was held in November of 1973. Greta Solgere shared her delicious recipe, one that has become famous in Greensburg through the years. From a tent with no electricity to an undercover area with lights and electric plug- ins, this tradition continued for 40 years, until 2013. (Daughters of Isabella barbeque sandwiches are still a mouthwatering treat!)

In October of 1867, St. Mary's Circle celebrated their 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Mass was held at St. Mary's Church with Father John Geis presiding. A procession was made up of members carrying the Crown, Cross, Banner, Charter, and a Memorial Candle. Members were Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and Song Leaders, and Joan Koors was the Organist. Many circles were present from all over the state to help celebrate this anniversary. A reception followed in St. Mary's School.

Next month our history will cover the years - October 1968-1977
