Pulling for Travis

At the end of June a very special event occurred at St. Mary's School. Many, many people from St. Mary's School, St. Mary's Parish, and the Greensburg community came together to hold a garage sale. The school gym, cafeteria and hallways were filled with donated clothing, furniture, and other items. This sale was held to raise money for the family of a very special boy, Travis Wenning. Travis is a first grader at our school who has been bravely battling lymphoma since November. The money raised from the sale is being given to the family to help with medical and transportation expenses. The final total has not yet been tabulated, but over \$16,000 has been raised!

There were so many people who helped in a variety of ways to make this event possible. We do not want to list names, as we are afraid we may miss many names. We do want to give our sincere gratitude to the following groups of people: **those who donated items, those who spent many hours sorting and displaying the items and packing up after the sale, those who helped out during the actual sale, and those who shopped and gave so generously to this cause.**

There were many items remaining after the sale. These items were donated to various local charities, thereby helping others in need. Charities receiving these donations included: Catholic Charities, New Directions, Edelweiss House, Twice Blessed (Oldenburg Academy), Kids Closet, Greensburg Library, Pregnancy Care/Clarity Center, a Prom Dress Charity, Transitional Learning Center, the Animal Shelter, and St. Vincent DePaul Charities. **Thank you also to all those individuals who helped to deliver these items to the charities.**

Did you know?

Last school year St. Mary's implemented a new approach to discipline titled "Virtue Based Restorative Discipline" (VBRD) This is an approach based on the virtues included in the Bible passage of Colossians 3:12-15. We have chosen the virtue of "Love" to be the overall theme both last year and the current year. During each quarter of the school year, the staff and students focus on one of the other virtues. 
