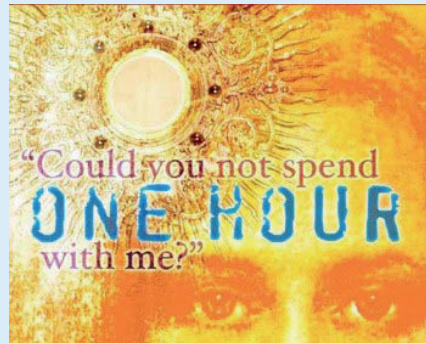
"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." (Luke 11:9)

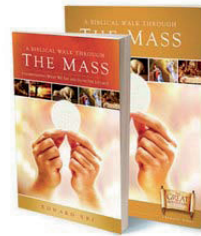

Frank is a graduate of Princeton University with a degree in Religion. After studying acting in New York and Los Angeles for 15 years, he attended Fuller Seminary in preparation for the writing and performance of his first one-man play, *AFRAID!: The Gospel of Mark*. He continued his studies at Yale Divinity School and General Theological Seminary, from which he received his Masters, with honors, in 1994. He workshopped his first productions in cooperation with the faculty of Holy Cross College in Worcester, Mass.

Miscarriage Ministry Update

The fundraising campaign for the Little Souls cemetery was met with tremendous support. The following is an update of the progress made and work to be finished for the project to become a reality.

- ◆ Plans for pouring the concrete are being finalized.
- ◆ The granite markers for individual burials have arrived.
- ◆ The burial vaults have been assembled.
- ◆ The upright monuments are complete.
- ◆ The landscaping design has been finalized.
- ◆ Below is a copy of a charcoal drawing that was commissioned (and donated by the artist). A likeness of this drawing will be carved in granite for the statue/bench combination. This image will also be used for printed materials of the ministry.
- ◆ Final details for the statue/bench are nearly complete.
- ◆ Totes containing miscarriage kits, casket, burial vessels, and vessel wraps have been developed. Gilliland Howe and Porter-Oliger-Pearson Funeral Homes now have totes at their facilities. When a family has a miscarriage or is getting ready to have a miscarriage, they can get everything needed for the burial of their baby.



Ways You Can Continue to Help

As the project has progressed, additional items have been identified. If you are interested in assisting with the items below, please contact Rebecca Harpring at 812-222-1881.

- ◆ Sod for replacement of grass disrupted during foundation work.
- ◆ Auguring 132 holes (approximately 10” wide and 20” deep) for the placement of the burial vaults.
- ◆ Set vaults in place, surround with sand and cover with dirt.
- ◆ Contact information for physicians or hospital departments who would like to have a miscarriage tote available in their facility.
- ◆ Prayer—We feel that God has been leading us through this whole project. Please pray that we bring this ministry to fruition according to His plan and will.
