

### And the Winner is...

On Saturday, November 2, the Speech Team of St. Mary's School competed in the Batesville Deanery Speech Contest. The team, comprised of 10 students from the fourth, fifth and sixth grades, competed against teams from the other schools in our deanery by delivering memorized speeches of a three-to-six minute length. There are three categories of speeches: Serious, Humorous, and Duets. Each student must present his or her speech twice to be evaluated by two different judges. Scores are then tabulated and ribbons are awarded based on the point totals earned. Blue ribbons signify a first place ranking and red ribbons are awarded to those whose point totals fall in the second place range.

St. Mary's students placed well this year. In the Serious Category three students earned a first place ranking: Carmin Ripperger, Declan Bruns, and Emma Richards. Two of the Humorous speeches brought home blue ribbons: Madison Gould and Sy Nobbe. Liam Tuchmann earned a red ribbon. In the Duet category, both teams earned blue ribbons: Wade Schutte/Ali Nobbe and Veda Fox/Kiera Kennelly. Two of our students earned the overall trophy for their respective categories: Madison Gould and Emma Richards. All of the students did a wonderful job and represented our school very well!

The traveling trophy for the highest scoring school now resides in our trophy case! Way to go, Knights!!. We are proud of the team and coaches: Mrs. Eva Volz, Mrs. Jen Blankman, and Ms. Deb Greiwe. You can be proud of a job well done!
