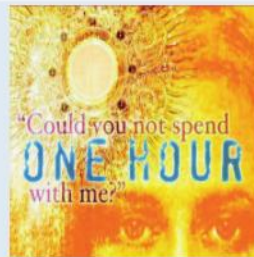

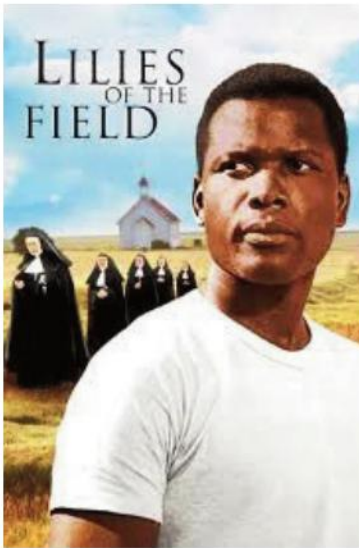
Did you know...?

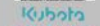
