Rite of Enrollment and Sending, Call to Continuing Conversion

During this time of Lent, we are called to a profound conversion of life. We are called to remember all that the Lord has done for us. We are called to let God change our hearts and have a greater place in our daily lives. On March 1 a sign of conversion to which the Lord calls is among us. That sign is our catechumens and candidates. They are proclaiming to us that they believe that God has called them to participate in the Easter mysteries of baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist, or for our candidates already baptized, to enter into full communion. They are entering into a more intense preparation of purification and enlightenment.

We, the Church, ratify their choice and send them with our encouragement, prayers, and support for election. We welcome them even more into our midst and witness our faith to them as they, by their conversion, call us also to conversion.

"Pray As You Go" also offers audio prayers, Imaginative Contemplation Exercises, an audio Rosary & Stations of the Cross, and an audio Examen.

Five Ways to Help Families Make Prayer a Priority

The hectic pace of family life can often mean that prayer gets lost in the shuffle. Here are five simple, practical tips to encourage families to pray more often:

- 1. When you rise from bed, get down on your knees
 Try this method for morning prayer: Put your bedroom slippers or shoes
 far under your bed at the end of the day. Each morning, while on your
 knees retrieving your footwear, say a quick prayer offering the whole
 day to God.
- 2. Communicate with God whenever you climb into the car Many families spend a whole lot of their time in the family vehicle. As you buckle up, say a quick prayer that you will be aware of God's presence in your day.
- 3. Place a prayer jar in the kitchen
- Keep a jar in the kitchen in which each family member, each day, places a note listing a "special intention" that others in the family can pray for. Before each family member goes to bed, he or she pulls a note from the jar and prays for that need.
- 4. Fold your hands before you unfold your napkin
 Before each meal, take a few moments to thank the One who provides
 all that you need and blesses you with the lives of those around the
 table. Try mixing up rote prayers with spontaneous prayers, silent
 prayers with sung prayers.
- 5. Pray when people or events upset you

If you want a sure-fire way to pray more each day, make a habit of saying a short prayer whenever someone irritates you. A quick "Help me, God" is sufficient. You'll never run out of opportunities!
