


#### **Every Day, Every Hour**



My Dear People,

In recent discussions among our Liturgical Ministers, particularly greeters and ushers, about the use of our Gathering Space, it was noted that welcoming you and opening the doors for you created a healthy and holy "tension". And, so, it was suggested that I address the topic here in the bulletin and/or at Mass.

As you may have noticed, the Gathering Space was built and decorated in a way as to express that it is as an extension of the church space. Not only does the carpeted floor indicate that it is a special area, it also provides some sound proofing that enables us to have fellowship and talk prior to and after entering the church space without being too loud for those praying in church. Having statues and candles within it also expresses its sacredness.

The healthy and holy tension occurs when our hospitality ministers, greeters, and ushers open the wooden doors for you into the church. That is a big help to many and a wonderful sign of welcome. But, since I have asked them to open the doors only for those who need to have them opened, it make them look unwelcoming!

So, I'm just asking you to understand that the greeters and ushers wish to talk with you and welcome you and will do so before the doors are opened as to not disturb those within church reflecting and praying.

During the winter, the outside doors will be left for you to open on your own, unless there is an obvious need to help you.

Secondly, the ushers would like you to make sure you let them know if you or a family member needs Holy Communion brought to you at a seat in the back rows of church, so that they can inform the ministers of Holy Communion or me.

Thank you very much for your understanding and your ideas and suggestions.




