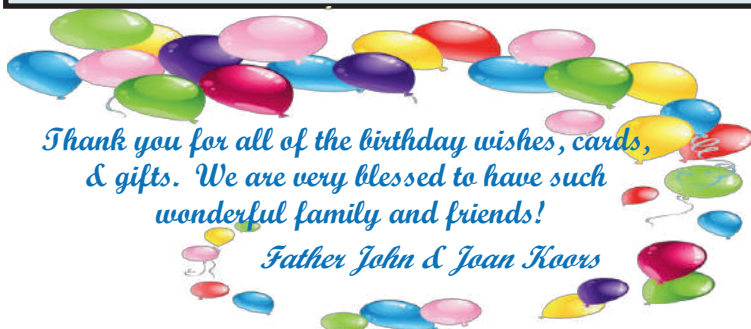

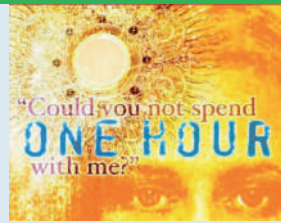

Ready for 2020-2021

The staff and teachers of St. Mary's School have been working extra hard this summer to be ready for this new school year no matter what that year looks like. The custodial staff has removed extra furniture from classrooms to make room for spacing the desks at a safe social distance. The teachers have been working to be ready for new procedures and new ways to teach with students being socially distanced. Lesson plans have been revamped and online options have been studied so that we are ready for whatever COVID-19 decides to throw at us. Even the cafeteria has received a make-over with plexiglass barriers being installed down the center of all of the tables to allow for a safer way to eat while still allowing kids time to talk with friends.

Mrs. Buening has been in constant communication with the local Department of Health as well as the Archdiocese and Greensburg Community Schools. A task force of teachers and staff have been meeting to decide how best to adhere to all of the guidance and recommendations from these entities. While this school year will be different in many ways, one thing will not change – the quality education provided by dedicated teachers and staff. We are prepared to keep our students as safe as possible from the potential spread of the virus by limiting the size of groups and having students remain in classrooms while teachers switch places in the upper grades. Please keep us all in your prayers as we prepare to return to school on August 3.
