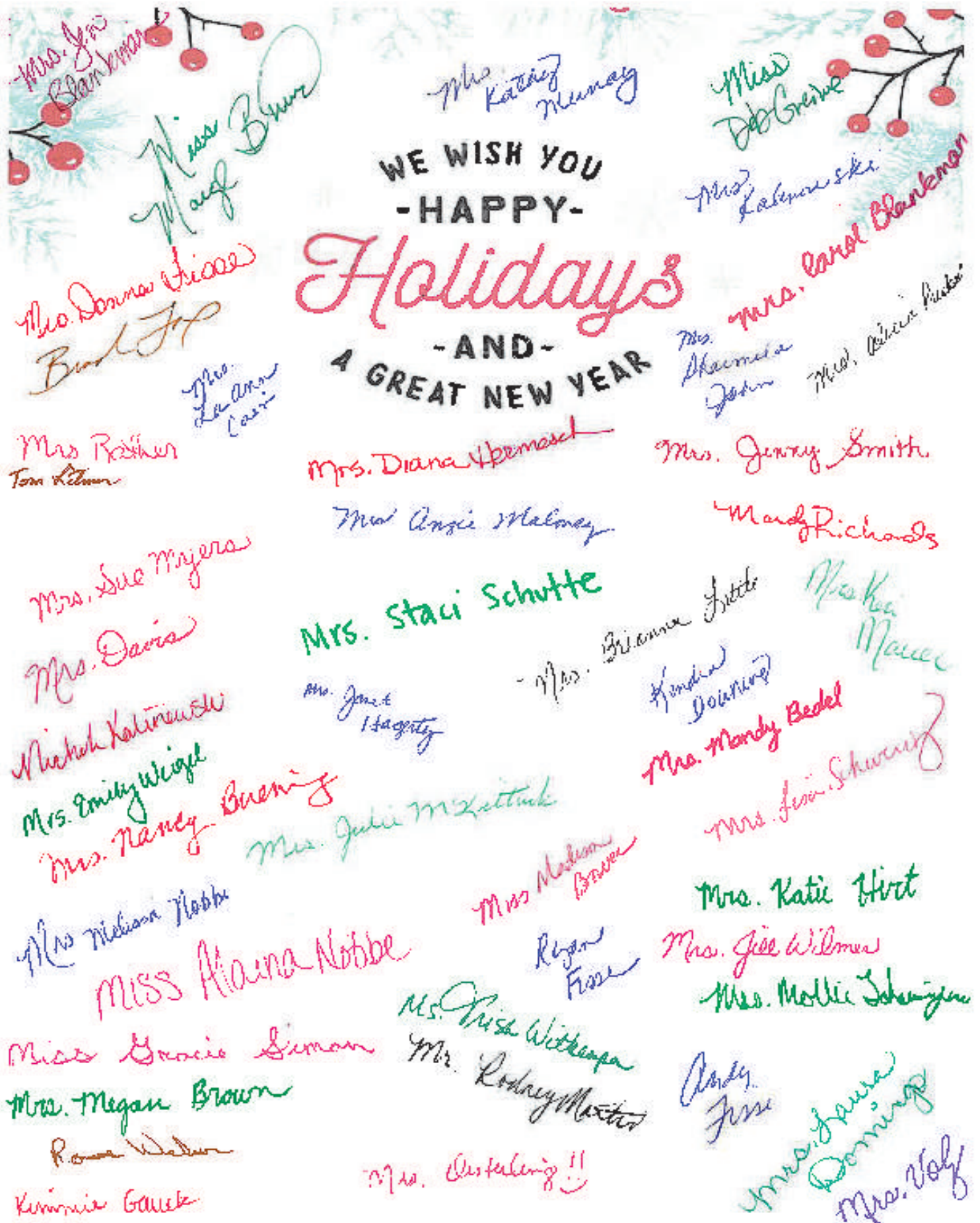

Greetings from the Mission! Within hours of mailing our November letter, the Navajo Nation issued their most strict guidelines yet to combat covid-19 since the beginning of the pandemic in March. This coincides with many other states issuing similar protocols because of the increase in infections and hospitalizations. "Hospitals" would be one of the many infrastructure items that the Navajo Nation does not have (small rural clinics, yes -- but not many hospitals). Because of that reality, you really don't want to get sick out here.

The other sad but anticipated reality is that we will have no public Christmas masses this year. I just can't comprehend that!!! In all my 46 years as a priest, this will be a first! Presently we do have "drive up" Holy Communion during the week, and that is probably all we will be able to do for Christmas. The Navajo people were severely tested in 1868 with the "long walk" -- they are being severely tested again (as we all are) with the "long wait" for a vaccine and a return to normalcy.

I celebrated Sr. Pat's one-year anniversary of death at mass on November 17 as well as remembering your All Souls intentions for the month of November. Again, with no parish income since March 8, your gift is a "God send" which prevents us from shutting down. Thank you and God bless you for your present gift of \$3757.00 on 12/7/2020!

Sr. Marlene, Br. Jose, & I wish you all the best during these final days of 2020 (and hopefully the final days of the pandemic). Sadly, we will say goodbye to Br. Jose in early December as he moves to Texas to care for his aging and ailing mother. Be assured of my prayerful support, and let's all find a way to make this Christmas life-giving for our family and friends.

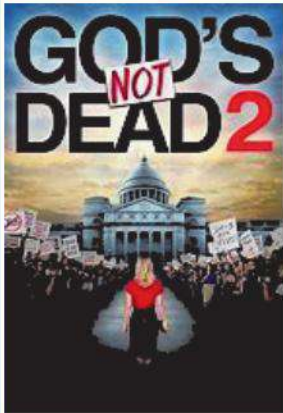
