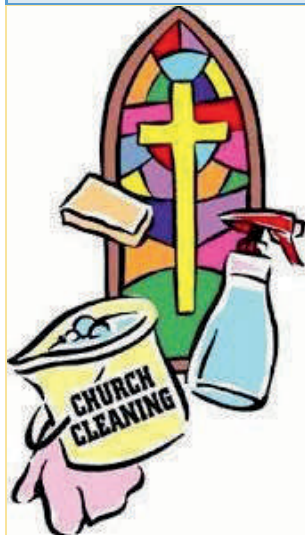
"Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' But they were startled and frightened..." Luke 24:36-37

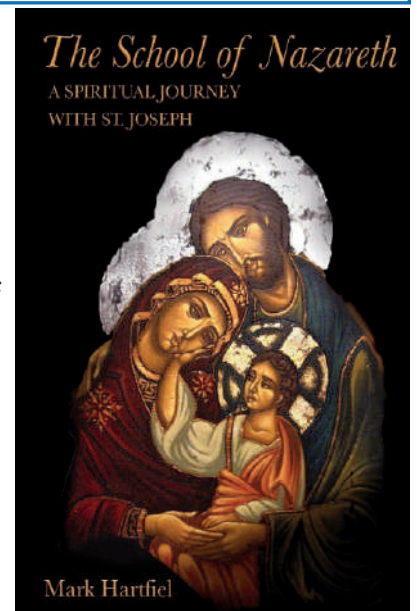

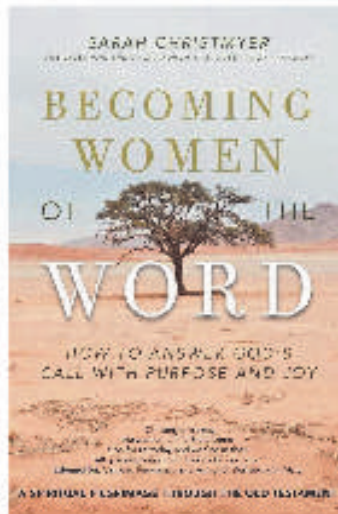

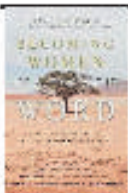
