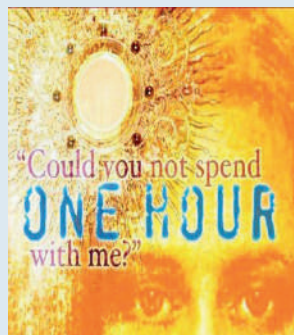

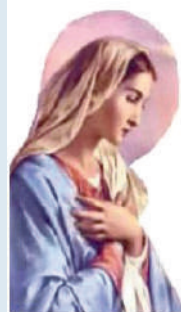

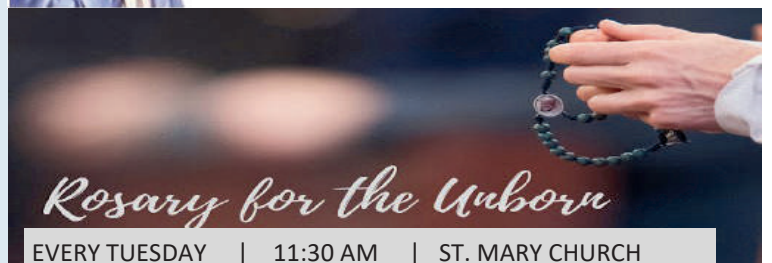

St. Mary's is currently in search of a Head Coach for the Middle School Girls Volleyball teams. There are many assistant coaches available to help, but we are looking for someone with playing

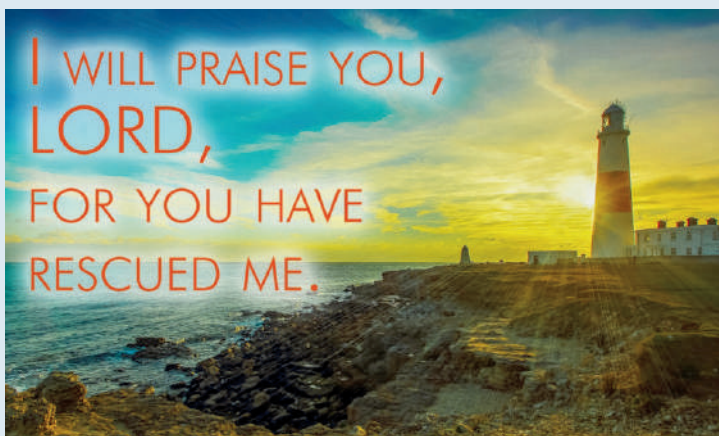
