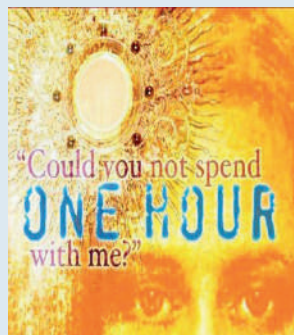

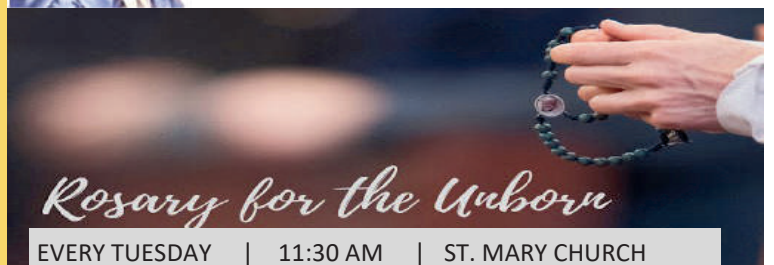

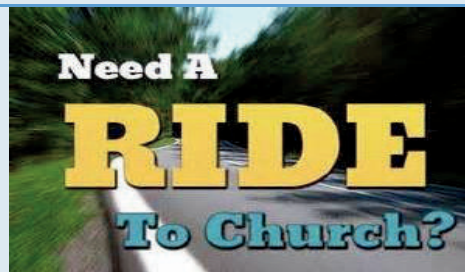


St. Mary's will be adopting a new cleaning schedule for the church for the rest of 2021 and beyond. This will be another stewardship opportunity of your time and talent.
