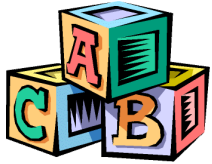

Guidelines and Policies



Parent Responsibilities

- *Please provide a diaper bag with appropriate items—diapers, bottles, change of clothes, snack.
- *Please label the diaper bag and all contents.
- *Parents bring and pick up children at the west Daycare entrance.
- *Please remember that children will only be released to the person that brought them to the nursery.
- *Please bring your card with the matching number to your child at pick-up time.
- *Please remember to sign your child in and out of the nursery.
- *Please keep your child at home if they have a rash, fever, vomiting, or cold symptoms such as sore throat, headache, drainage, in the last 24 hours.

Security

- *First aid kits are in the nursery cabinet.
- *All workers must participate in Safe and Sacred Training through our Archdiocese.
- *Only nursery workers should be allowed in the daycare.
- *At least one volunteer on site will be CPR certified.

Nursery Workers Responsibilities

- *Medications may not be administered by volunteers.
- *Volunteers will arrive at least 20 minutes prior to Mass.



- *Name tags should be worn by all volunteers at all times to identify themselves to parents and visitors.
- *Parents are to be contacted if a child continues to cry and seems distressed.
