



Thank a Teacher Grants

We are excited to announce that two of our teachers have been awarded “Thank-a-Teacher” grants from the Decatur County Community Foundation this spring. We have several students in the primary grades who speak Spanish as their first language and Mrs. Schutte has been taking some graduate level classes to learn better strategies for helping these students to become fluent in speaking, reading and writing English. These books will help the students to bridge the gap between their native language and the English language that they are learning at school.

Mrs. Laura Domingo received a grant for her “Rather Be Reading” middle school book club. She will use the money to purchase more copies of books for the club as well as some bookshelves on wheels. Her eventual goal is to be able to set up a coffee shop type atmosphere for the club meetings. The grant money is going to help get the idea off the ground. Both teachers are very thankful to have such a generous organization who can help with these extra classroom wish lists. 
