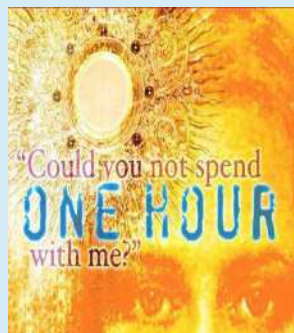

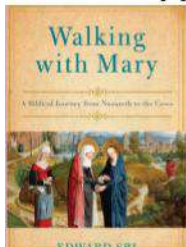

- Vacation Bible School preparation is going well; will be looking for more leaders/aides
- 22 students from St. Mary were confirmed
- The graduation Mass will be the 8 AM Mass on May 22nd

Stewardship

- Sign ups will be coming for church directory pictures

- They are providing information in the bulletin that ties stewardship to the Mass readings

Maintenance
