

The available times are Friday evenings (after 7 P.M.) and Saturday mornings (must be finished before 10 AM). Thank you for your willingness to keep our beautiful space clean and safe for our parish.





Our teachers have been participating in online training modules to become more aware of concerns that could potentially affect the students we teach. These videos give facts and statistics as well as warning signs and ways to handle the situation should it arise. The topics for these trainings include child abuse, bullying recognition and response, bloodborne pathogen exposure, student homelessness, youth suicide prevention and awareness, and human trafficking awareness. While we would like to think that these topics are not relevant to our school population, we need to be aware of these topics because, unfortunately, we could face a situation and we need to be prepared to recognize it and respond appropriately.

We also have the option to watch training videos on other topics of our own choice through this service. There are videos about sudden cardiac arrest in athletes, heat illnesses, concussions and head injuries, and even seizures. These optional topics can be viewed by any teacher who wishes to familiarize herself just in case a situation arises. It is helpful to have access to the latest information about topics that could affect students in our classroom or building. We can feel more confident in handling emergencies with the training we can access. All of the time that is spent watching the videos and taking the quizzes at the end is counted towards our professional development that is required to renew our teaching licenses.
