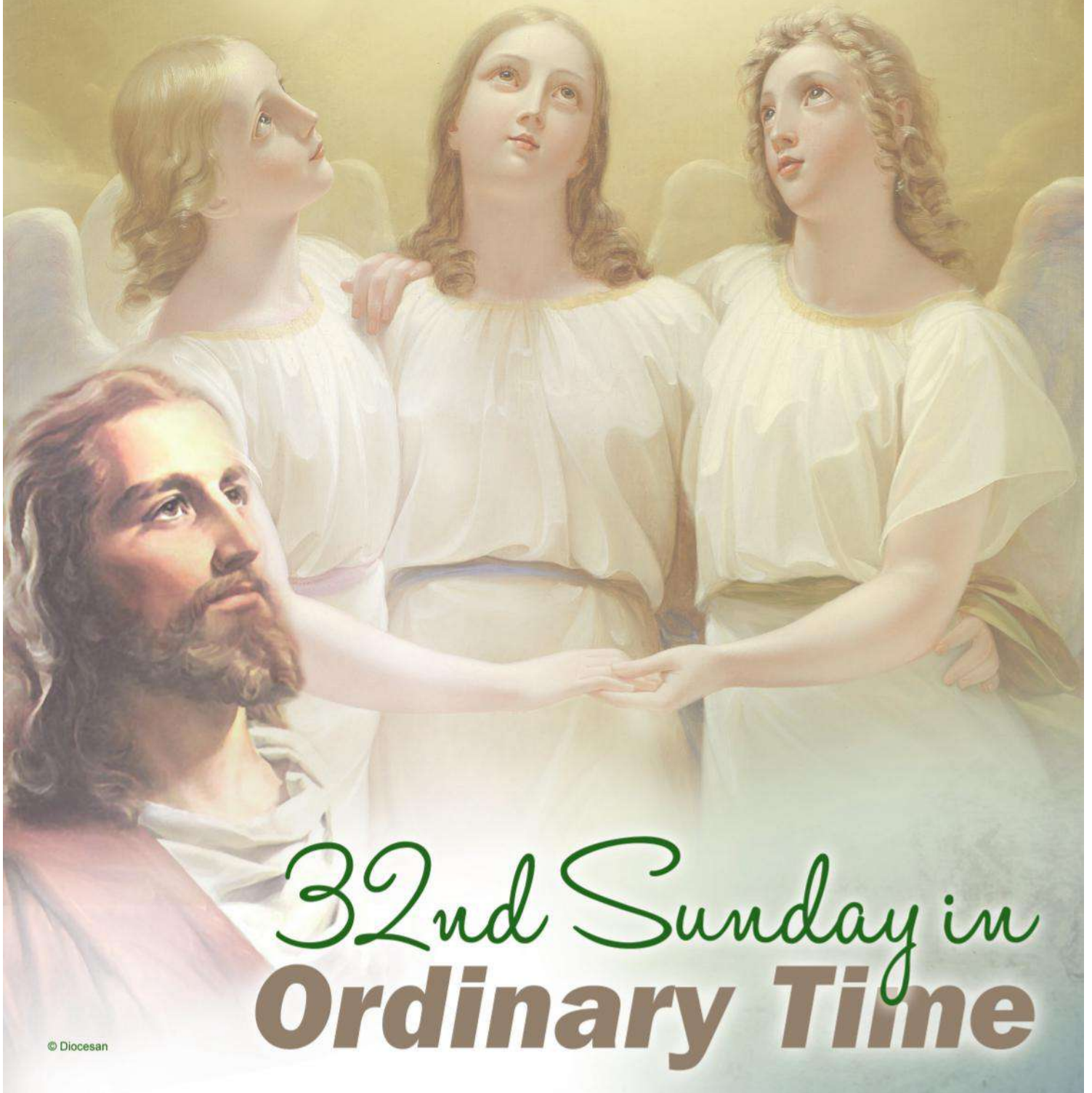

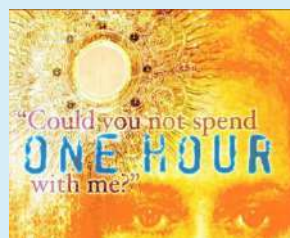

Red Ribbon Week

The last week of October is nationally known as Red Ribbon Week. It is a time to focus on making good choices and saying “No” to drugs, tobacco, vaping, and alcohol. Each teacher addresses these topics in the manner that is appropriate for the age of the students in the classroom. It is never too early to think about making positive choices.

The entire school did a few activities to celebrate Red Ribbon Week. We kicked off the week with an out of uniform day so that all students and staff could wear RED. At the end of the day we gathered in the school lawn to take a photo with all of the students and teachers forming the shape of a giant heart. Also on Monday, every student was given a red bracelet and pencil reminding him/her to make good choices.

On Tuesday the students were once again allowed to be out of uniform so that they could wear bright neon colors. The theme of the day was, “We are too bright to do drugs!” Each day students were also drawn out of a hat to win some prizes just for wearing their red bracelets. And each morning a group of middle school students presented a self-created scenario over the PA system in which a fictitious student had to make a tough choice about saying “No” to drugs and alcohol. These were thought provoking and helped the younger students realize how difficult it can be to do the right thing.

Our week culminated with a visit from one of the local K9 units from GPD. Sergeant Joe Radcliff brought Hercules and his handler, Officer Stephen Hershberger, to talk with the students and let them see how Hercules does his work of sniffing out drugs in our community. We really appreciate them taking time to visit our school!

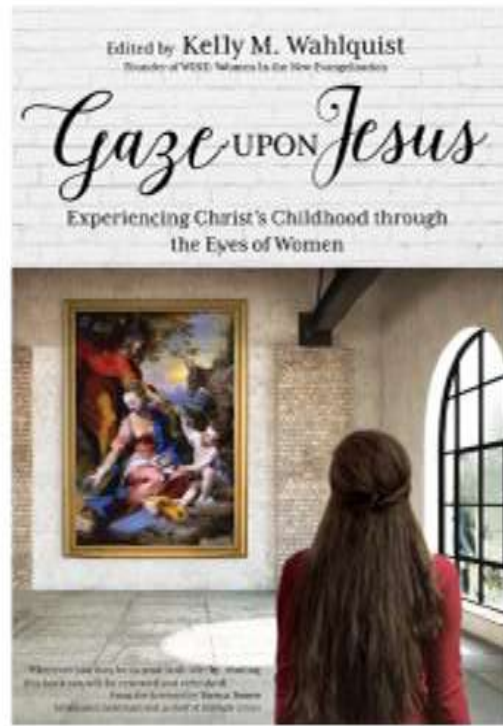

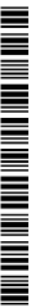

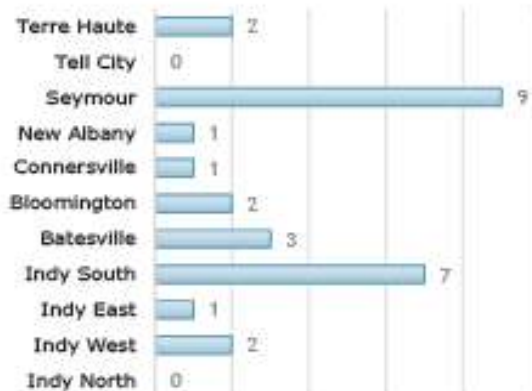
SEMINARIANS FOR THE ARCHDIOCESE OF INDIANAPOLIS

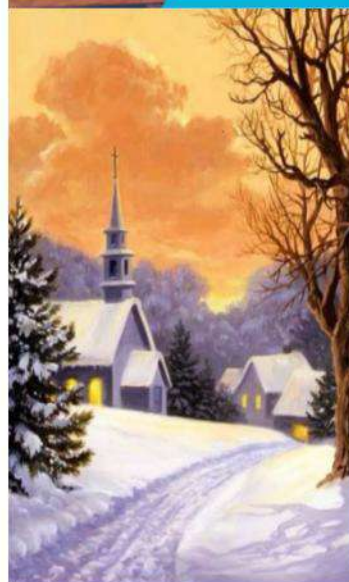
