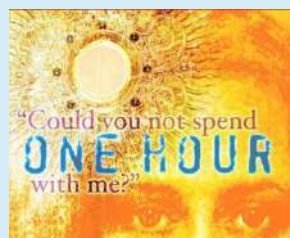

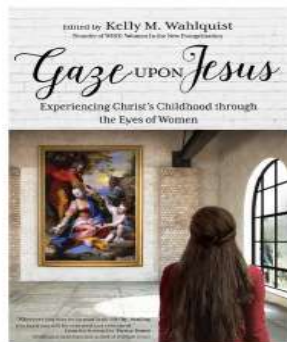

We spoke to the St. Mary's community in January, asking for your help to build a medical clinic in Gandou, Haiti. God called upon your generosity, and you responded with an open heart! To date, \$366,000 of the \$438,000 required to complete construction and furnishing of the clinic has been raised. 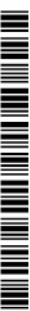
Because of you, the new clinic will improve lives for many years to come. In addition, many of the construction workers are local and the work has been a blessing to a struggling economy.
