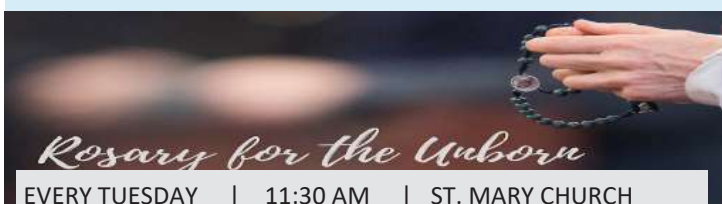

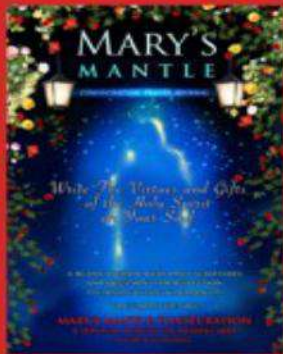

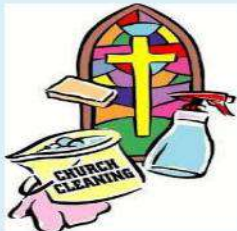

St. Mary's is still looking for crews for our new cleaning schedule for the church for the rest of 2022 and beyond. This will be another stewardship opportunity of your time and talent.

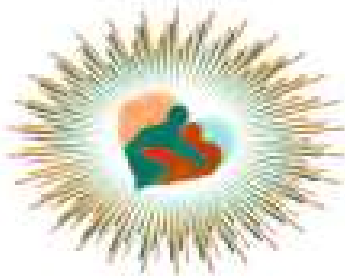


