# Bike Safety Program

On Friday, December 16, we had a special visitor from INDOT (Indiana Department of Transportation). Mrs. Walker came to talk to all of the students in grades K-2 about the importance of bicycle (or any wheeled vehicle) safety. She used a variety of short informational videos and live demonstrations to illustrate the reasons why helmets should be worn whether riding bikes, scooters, skateboards, or skates.

She demonstrated how to properly wear a helmet – two finger widths above the eyebrows and snug enough to only slip a pinky finger between the chin strap and the chin. She talked about the importance of being able to hear your surroundings while biking which means no earbuds or earphones. She went over the rules of riding on the road – ride with traffic, follow all traffic signs and make sure you can be seen by wearing bright colors. She even talked about what to wear and not wear when riding by using a fun trunk full of dress-up clothes. Kids were amused to see how a mask and a monkey tail would not be good biking attire!

At the conclusion of this informative and interactive presentation, each student was given a drawstring backpack with a brand new bike helmet! The students were excited and thankful for this pre-Christmas gift from INDOT.



Jesus' baptism began a "new creation." And your baptism, also begins your new life."






