





National Speaker, Susan Vogt, will share some foibles from her own marriage of 50 years plus principles from marriage counseling. Bottom line is:



#### What is Mary's Mantle?

Participants will read a short daily meditation based on the Theological Virtues, the Cardinal Virtues, the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit, or other Catholic jewels of wisdom. Then use this meditation theme to pray the rosary. There is also fasting, but do not fear or let this stop you. Modified fasting is an option. At the end of the 46 days there will be an opportunity for Consecration to Mary.

#### When?

This program will start Wednesday, February 22, 2023 (Ash Wednesday) and end on Saturday, April 8, 2023 (Holy Saturday).

#### Options

This program is mostly individual, as you will read the meditation and pray the rosary on your own. There are 2 options for interaction with others, you may do one or both:

- In Person There are 6 weekly videos that accompany the program. We will have these available in the small
  meeting room to watch as a group. These videos do not have to be seen in order or all together, so if there
  are any times when you can not make it to an in person video, do not let that hold you back from one of the
  others. We will also have a wrap up meeting after the program for fellowship. Date are: March 2, 7, 16, 21,
  30, and April 4.
- Online We will post the daily readings and links to the videos in the Relatable Rosary facebook group. This
  would allow for some interaction if people in the group chose to share through comments. Email is an option
  for those without facebook. We will email the daily readings and links to the videos for those who sign up for
  this option.

#### Cost

The Mary's Mantle Book is \$12, there is an optional Mary's Mantle Prayer Journal that is also \$12. We HIGHLY recommend the Prayer Journal as it includes additional prayers, scripture, and reflections for each day. Even if you do not use the journal space we highly recommend it. If you are not able to afford both books the daily readings from the book are available online so we would recommend purchasing the journal. If cost of either would keep you from the program, reach out to Wendy Blake or Jen Blankman; they will help with possible solutions.




