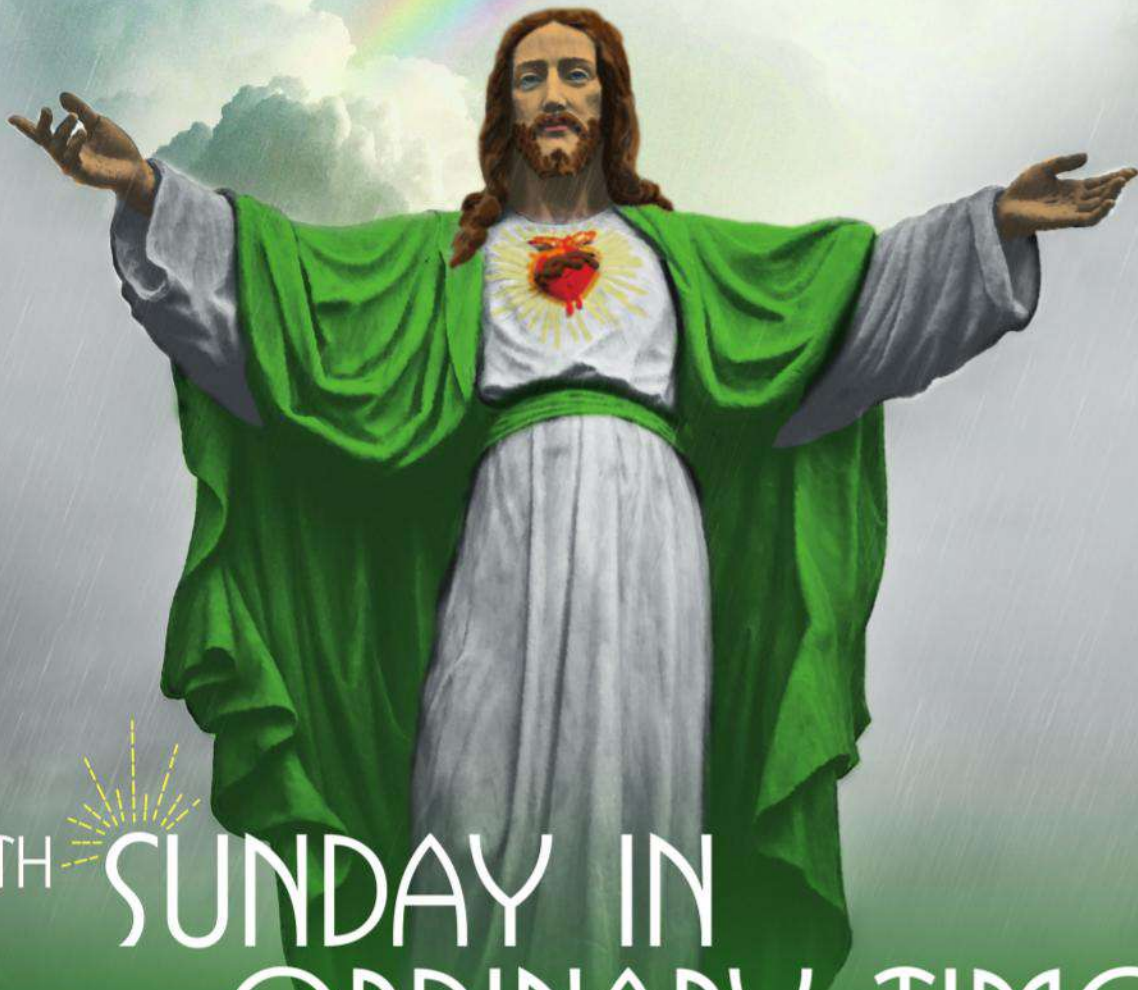

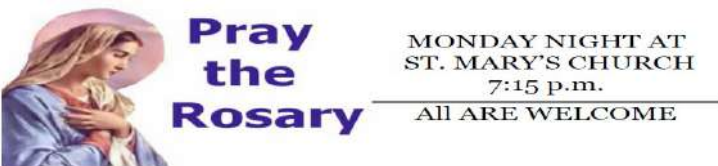
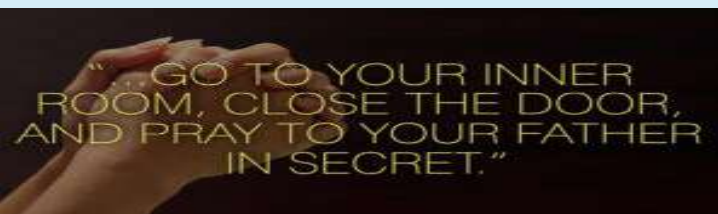

Our Lenten journey will begin with the celebration of Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, with Mass and Distribution of Ashes at 7:00 AM and 5:30 PM with a School Mass at 8:15 AM.

Each year the Lenten season calls us to grow a little more in our faith as we take a long careful look at ourselves and "scrutinize" our words and actions. The Church gives us three disciplines to help us along the way - PRAYER - FASTING - ALMSGIVING. Lent also prepares us for our celebration of Easter, as we walk, together, with our RCIA group preparing for their baptism and we recalling our baptism and just how we are living our baptismal promises each day.

As we begin our Lenten observance we will ask the Holy Spirit to help us see every person as a Child of God and the grace to see the "Body of Christ" in one another.

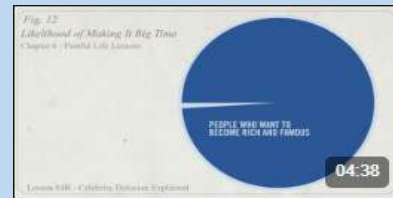
