"I HAVE CHOSEN YOU - COME FOLLOW ME"

Each year the Lenten season calls us to grow a little more in our faith as we take a long careful look at ourselves and "scrutinize" our words and actions. The Church gives us three disciplines to help us along the way - PRAYER - FASTING - ALMSGIVING. 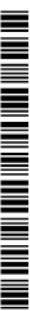
