

FUNDRAISER FOR THE GEIS TWIN BOYS

Jenny Siebert and Grant Geis were excited to find out in July that they were expecting their first child. In November at their 20-week ultrasound, it was discovered that they were having twins! Jenny went into pre-term labor in December, the twin boys were diagnosed with TTTS (Twin-Twin Transfusion Syndrome), a complication of monochorionic multiple pregnancies where there is disproportionate blood supply between fetuses.
