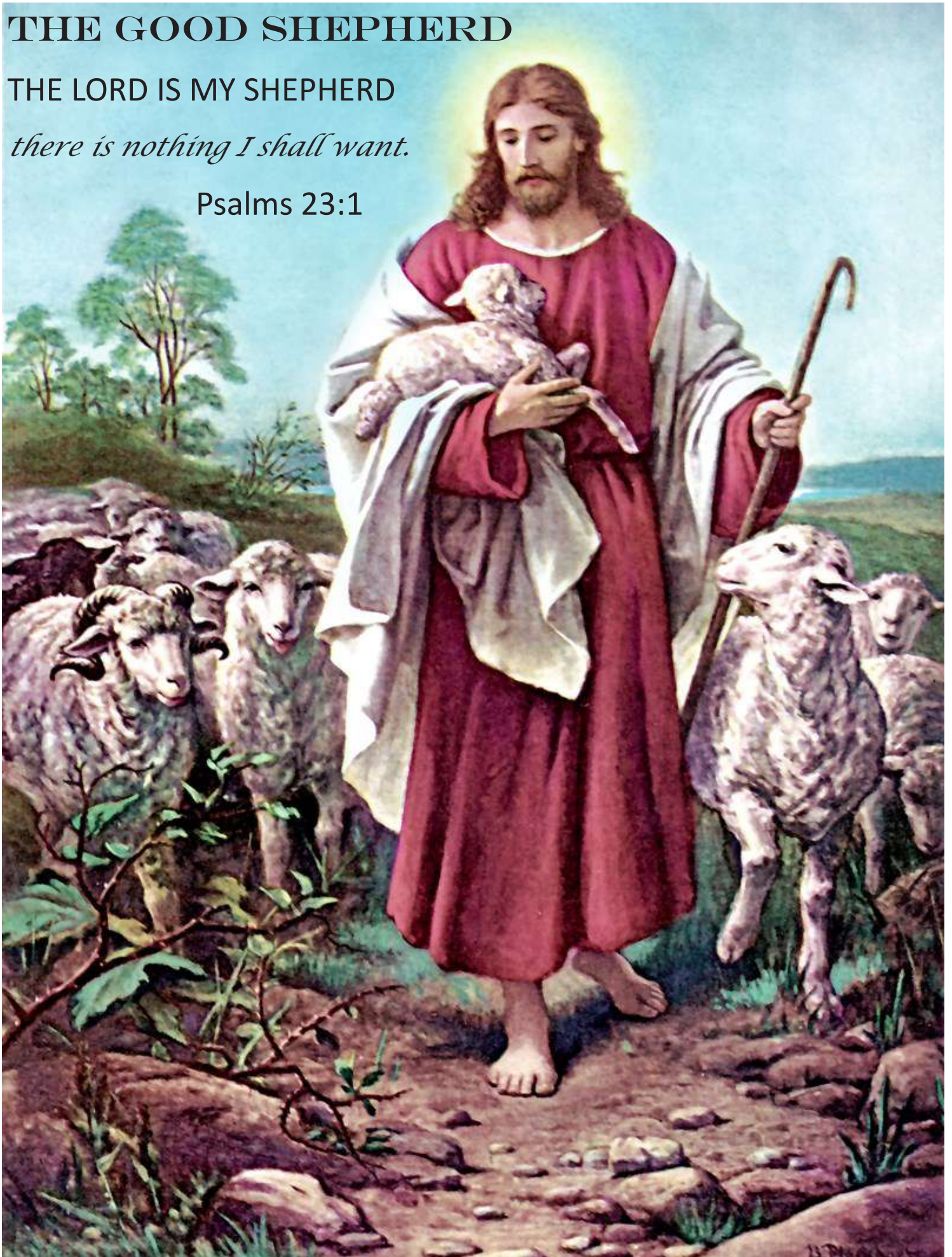

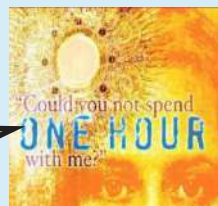

STEAM Showcase Projects

On May 2, the St. Mary's middle school will once again be having a STEAM Showcase. STEAM is an acronym that stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts, and Math. Students have been asked to come up with a project that falls into one or more of these categories and present it at the Showcase. In a past article, Alaina Schwering's project to make blankets for Clarity was highlighted. Here are the projects of two more of our eighth grade students that are making a difference in our school and community.

On April 4, Hannah Fuel held a Drone information and training session for interested students. She demonstrated how to fly a drone and talked about uses for drones. She also let some students try their hand at controlling the drone.

Alaina Bedel focused her project on Earth Day (April 22) and the problem of trash in the ditches along county roads. She sent out fliers to St. Mary's families asking them to pick up trash in a roadside ditch somewhere in the county and send her a picture of their collection before taking it to the recycling center or the dump. Not only will this project make our county cleaner and more beautiful, but it will help the environment and wildlife in the county.

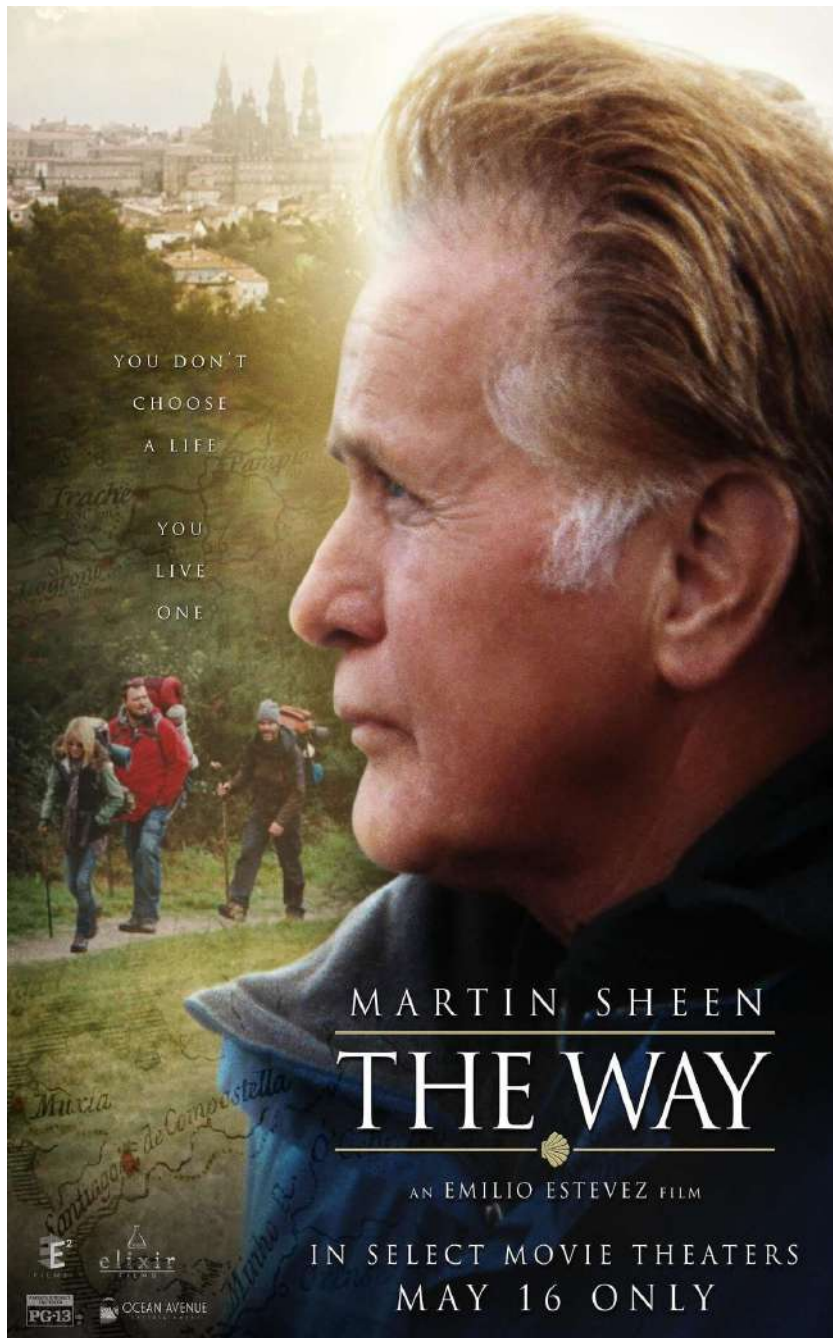

The movie "The Way", referring to the "Way of St. James, or "El camino de Santiago de Compostela", which inspired me to hike portions of this pilgrimage in Spain, is showing in Cincinnati and Indianapolis on Tuesday, May 16 at 7 pm. I encourage you to take this "easy way" to make the pilgrimage and maybe one day join me for real!

"Since its theatrical release in 2011, Emilio Estevez's film THE WAY has been "running a quiet marathon" garnering millions of fans across all generations; widely admired by those who see the film as a rare work of art, uniquely balancing faith and doubt; sorrow and joy. 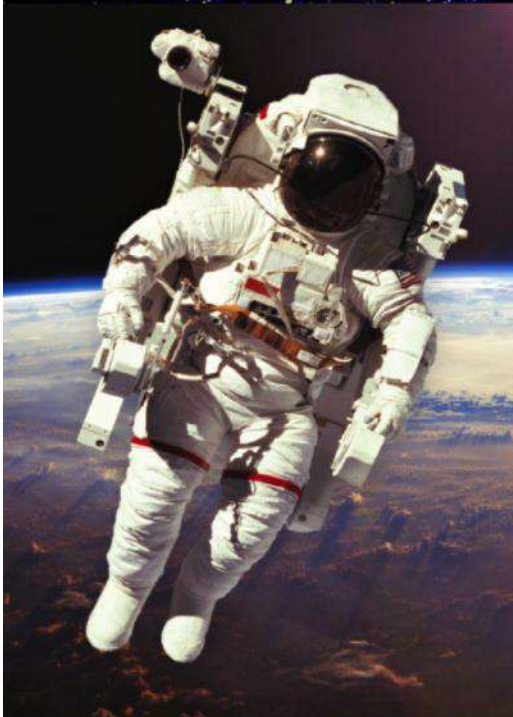
