

The program is Christ-centered and a very sacred space. I found support, help with navigating through my grief and trust in this program. I attended several different Seasons and found that each one uniquely helped me. Discovering this program helped me see that I was not alone in my suffering. SOH is truly a hidden treasure, a beautiful gift to a grieving heart.


ABOUT THE AUTHOR


