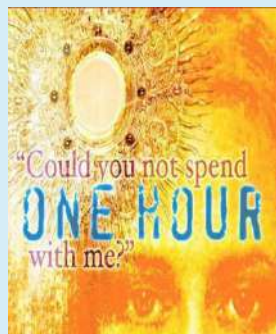

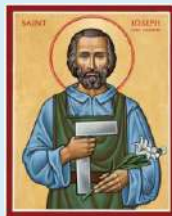

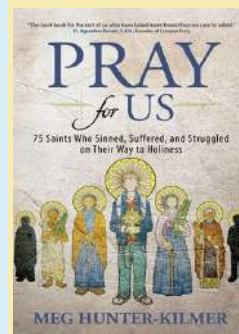

SOH is truly a hidden treasure, a beautiful gift to a grieving heart.

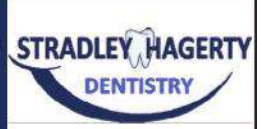
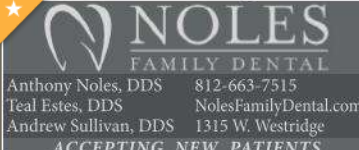

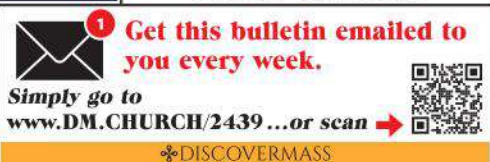
