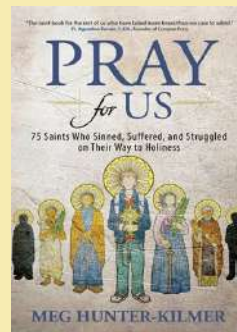

It explores the universal call to holiness and how God can transform anyone—from grouchy theologians to bratty teenagers—into saints. St. Mary's Faith Families

In an effort to increase the camaraderie between classes in our building, the entire school (grades K-8) has been divided up into "Faith Families". Each homeroom teacher is the head of one of these families which is made up of students from each grade level. The Families get together once per quarter to do activities based on the virtues and/or other community building topics.

Our first Faith Family get-together this year will be held on Tuesday, September 12. The families will meet their new members - kindergarteners and other new students in our building - and create new leaves for the family trees which hang in the hallway to the east of the gym. Each leaf is decorated with the name and symbols of interests that the student has. The families will then discuss the virtue of the first quarter, kindness. The teacher will pose some questions about kindness for the group to answer in a "circle". Circles are a part of our Virtues Based Restorative Discipline where a small "talking piece" is passed around and only the person holding the talking piece can speak. This helps the students learn to take turns speaking and gives everyone the chance to speak and be heard.

Students really look forward to these Faith Family activities. They enjoy connecting with students from other grades and having the chance to meet new people. We have found this is a great way to build community while also focusing on our virtues.

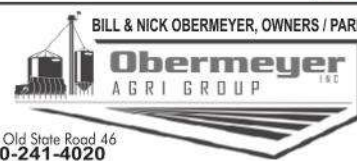
