



Red Ribbon Week

Thursday was Sports Day to remind us to “Team up to make healthy choices.” Kids were reminded that being an athlete means that you need to keep your body healthy and your mind clear so that you can compete to the best of your ability and help your team be successful.

Friday we celebrated Twin Day, asking students to dress like a classmate of their choosing. This was in keeping with the idea that “My brain and healthy choices make a good pair.” We reminded students that using drugs and alcohol has an adverse effect on the brain.

Also, on Friday we welcomed Nathan Harmon of Your Life Speaks. He met with different grade levels individually so that he could tailor his talk to be appropriate for each audience. The Greensburg Prevention Group helped us fund this convocation so that our students could hear his important message about how their choices really have a big impact on the lives of others.




