

Holiday Outreach

Once again, our school focused on being the hands of Jesus in the community throughout the holiday season. The sixth grade class was busy during the second week of Advent working in the Santa's Dollar Tree shop on our school stage. They set up a "store" filled with donated items and then sold these items to students for \$1 per item so that they could get gifts for their family members all on their own. The "store" was so popular that they sold out by Thursday morning! They were able to raise \$916 for two organizations that are close to their hearts- the Make a Wish Foundation and Riley Hospital for Children. They made their donations in memory of their classmate, Travis Wenning, who benefited from both during his battle with cancer.


