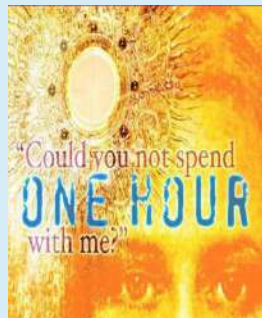

Robotics Team

The Wired Knights – St Mary's Robotics Team - with teammates Zach Roell, Cole Alexander, David Lutterbach, Jacob Roell and John Harpring, has had a very successful season. Since last fall they have worked with their coaches to design and build a Lego-based robot with changing attachments to accomplish goals set forth by the Lego League Tournament directors. This included putting together mechanical parts and software programming to make the robot go through a series of tasks such as pushing, pulling, lifting, and turning levers of different kinds.

On November 11th they participated in a qualifying tournament and finished 2nd. This performance allowed them to advance to the semi-state round held in Evansville on December 10th. At semi-state they finished 3rd for robot performance and, after their presentation, came in 2nd overall. This allowed them to advance to the State Championship which was held on January 20th in Indianapolis. We are proud to announce that they finished in 4th place at the State meet. The team thanks everyone for the encouragement they have received.
