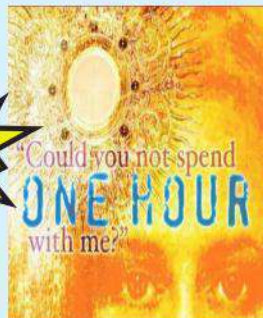

Pennies for Honduras

St. Mary's Student Council organized a fundraiser to help earn money for the parish's Adopt a Village project in Honduras. During the week of May 6-10, students were encouraged to bring in loose change or even bills for a little friendly – or in the case of the middle school – not-so-friendly competition to see which classrooms could raise the most money.

Students in grades K-5 just did a collection and the money was counted to determine the average per-pupil donation. The classes with the highest average in each grade level division were declared the winners and earned a game time with some Student Council members.

In the middle school, there was a Penny War. Each homeroom had a donation bucket and all the pennies that were placed in the bucket counted as positive points. Any silver coins that were in the bucket were negative points for the class. This allowed for other classes to donate silver money to their opponents while adding as many pennies as possible to their own bucket. Things got pretty wild and scheming was in full swing to end up with the highest total (or the least negative!) by Friday.

Overall, our school raised \$2,749.24 for the Honduras Adopt-a-Village project! What a great week!!

The Father • The Son • The Holy Ghost

In Catholic theology, we understand the persons of the Blessed Trinity subsisting within the inner life of God to be truly distinct relationally, but not as a matter of essence, or nature. Each of the three persons in the godhead possesses the same eternal and infinite divine nature; thus, they are the one, true God in essence or nature, not “three Gods.” Yet, they are truly distinct in their relations to each other. From all eternity, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit have poured themselves out into each other in an infinite act of love, which we, as Christians, are called to experience through faith and the sacraments by which we are lifted up into that very love of God itself (Romans 5:1-5). It is the love of God that binds us, heals us, and makes us children of God (I John 4:7; Matt. 5:44-45). Thus, how fitting it is that the Holy Spirit is depicted in Revelation 22:1-2, as a river of life flowing out from the Father and the Son and bringing life to all by way of bringing life to the very “tree of life” that is the source of eternal life in the Book of Revelation (Rev. 22:19).

Gloria is a young woman, 27, who is a single mother of 3 children: Victor – 9, Ptolemy – 6, and Fonte – 3. The boys were coloring pictures and one was writing his numbers beyond 8,000 while we visited. She has to take her children to work with her and on a good day makes only 90 Lempiras (\$3.65). Her rent is being raised from 500 Lempira to 1000 Lempira/month.
