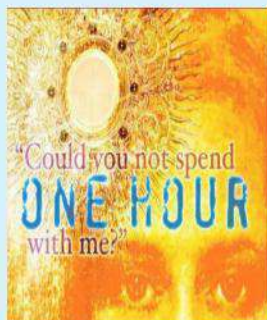

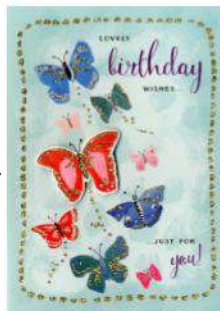
Criterion

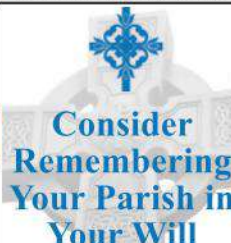
