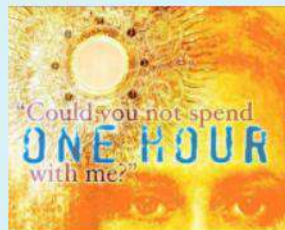

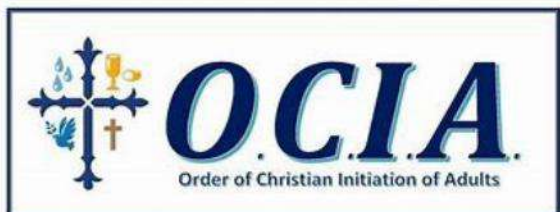
Did you know?

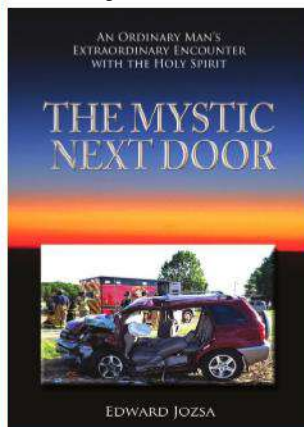

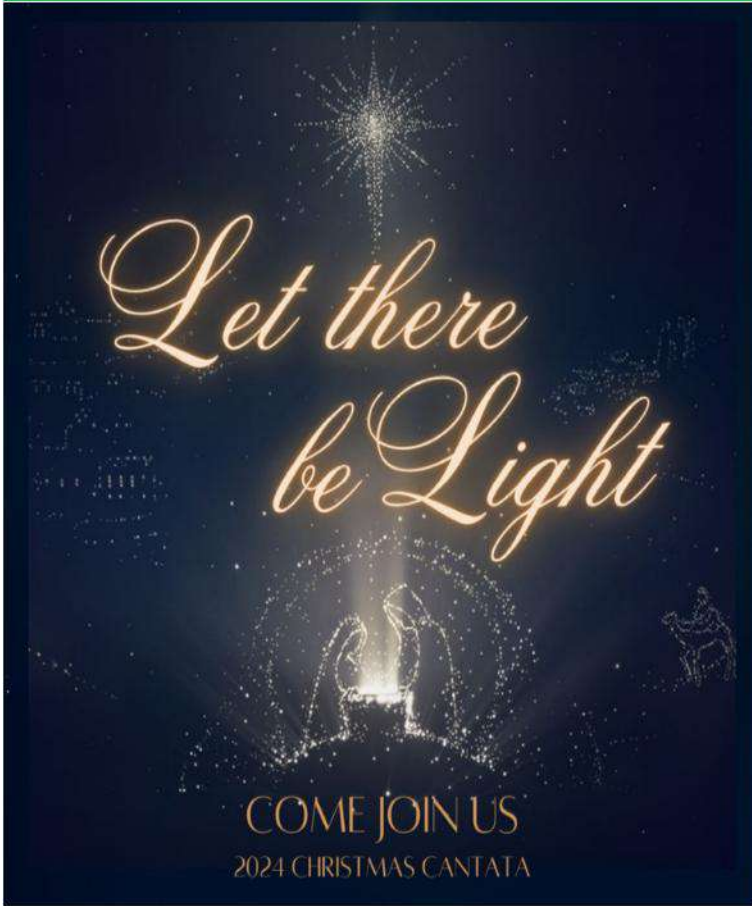

ALUMINUM CAN COLLECTION.

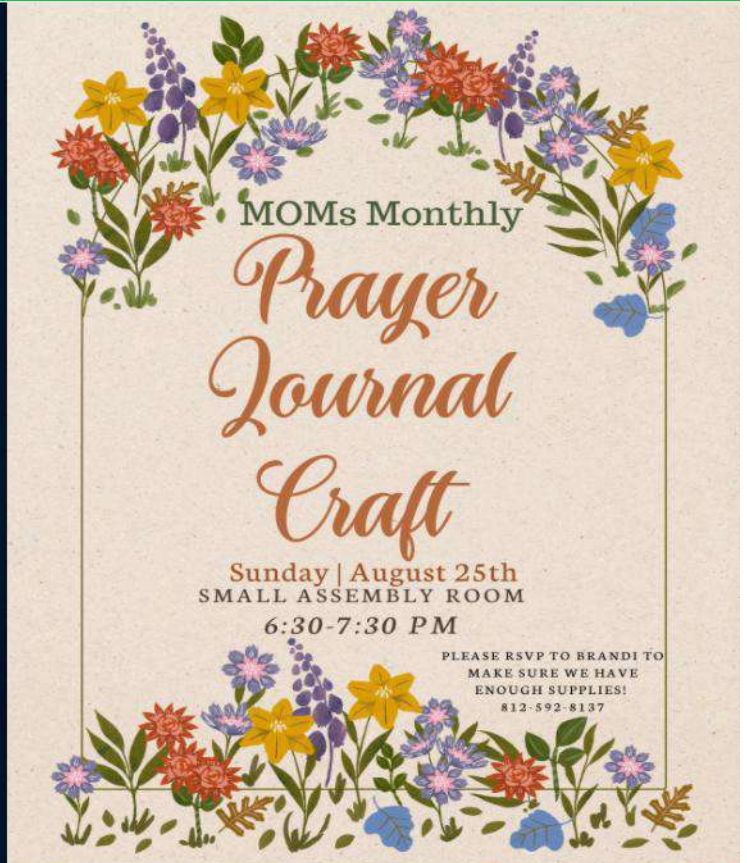

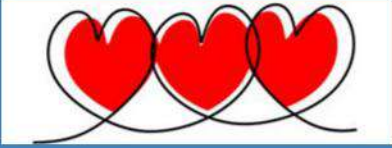
