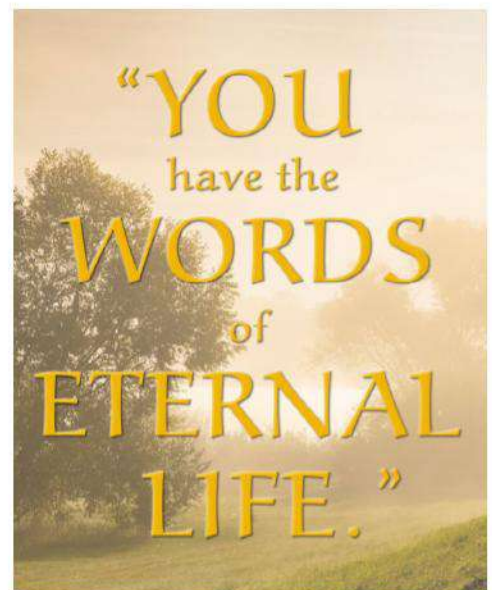


**Mary’s Rosary Warriors**

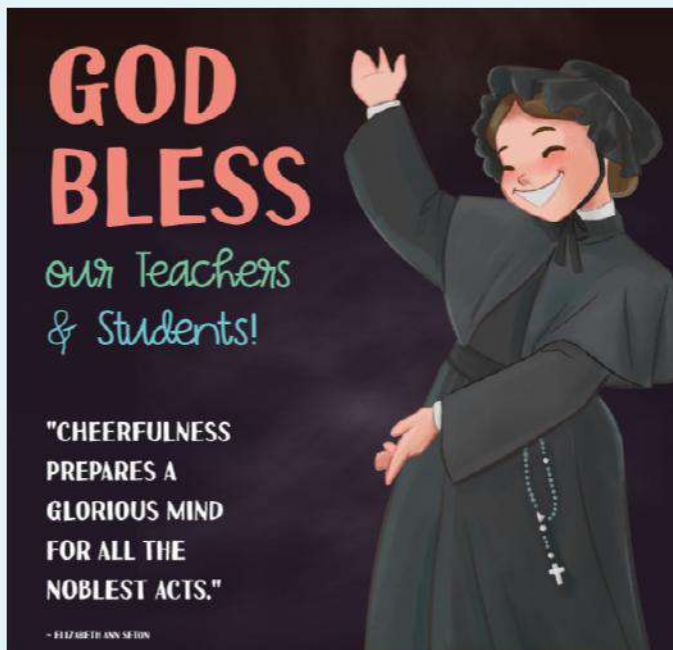

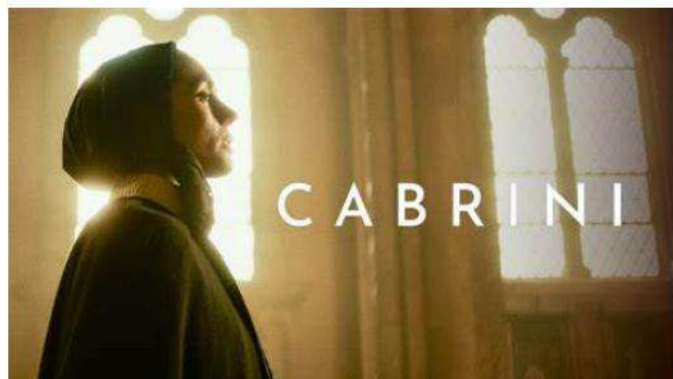

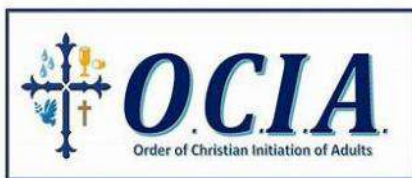


### Order of Christian Initiation of Adults O.C.I.A.

### The Mystic Next Door

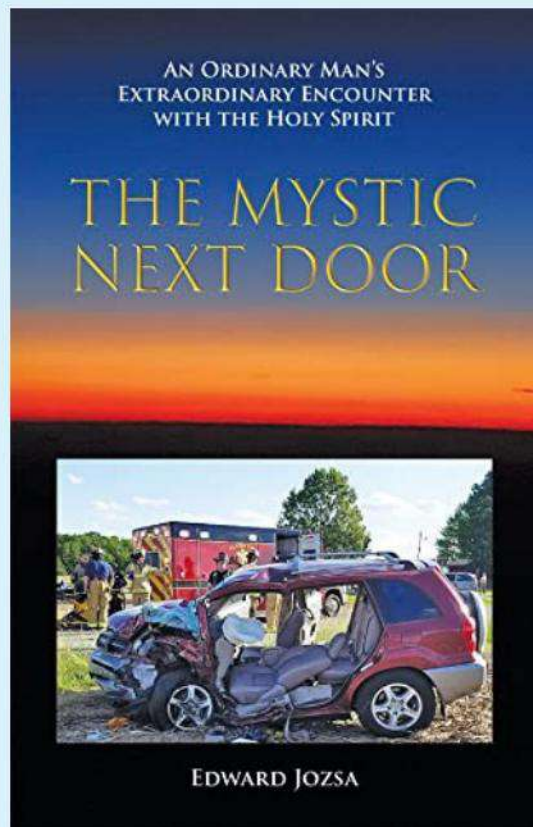

It is a true story of struggle and faith. It is also a great love story.

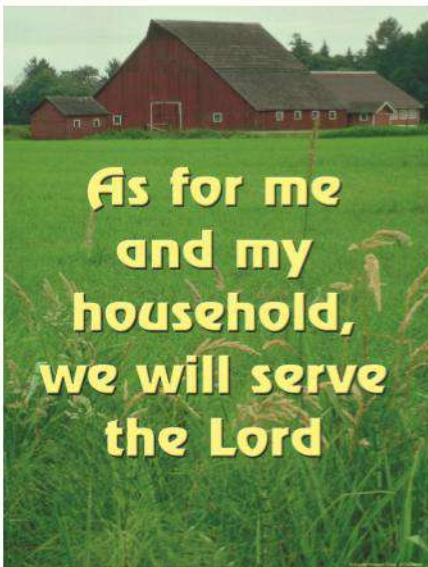

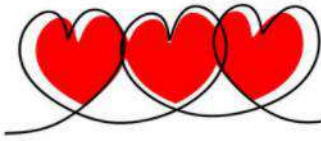
