The boys placed first and brought home the traveling trophy! Fletcher Hash 2nd (12:28), Nolan Hash 3rd (12:48), Nolan Wells 5th (13:18), Maxwell Gauck 6th (13:44.2), Andrew Stier 7th (13:44.4), and Landen Fuel 9th (14:58) all earned top 10 ribbons!

The girls also ran an outstanding race, placing second in the invite! Caitlyn Kendall (13:49), Josie Slaven (13:52), and Kelsey Slaven (14:08) were in the top 10 placing 5th, 6th, and 7th respectively. Tessa Hersley (17:12), Alex Fry (17:54), and Sydney Fry (18:00) ran closely together, placing 12th, 13th, and 14th respectively. Caroline Lutterbach (19:11), Kendal Nesbit (19:32), Briley Stier (19:37), Ava Meyer (19:37), Anna Davis (19:39) and Gwen Gauck (27:53) all showed improvements in their first race of the season.

St. Mary's Cross Country runners competed in their second meet of the season on Monday, August 19th at home against Batesville and Columbus Christian. The boys won the meet, beating Batesville by 1 point. The boys all ran season best times. The girls also ran a great race, placing second in the meet behind Batesville. Caitlyn Kendall 3rd (13:11), Josie Slaven 4th (13:20), and Kelsey Slaven 6th (13:33) placed in the top 10 with season best times.

St. Mary's Cross Country teams competed in the Greensburg Invitational on Monday, August 26th. The boys placed 12th out of 26 teams and most of them saw improvements on their times compared to when they ran the course in the County Invite. Nolan Hash (12:39) led the Knights with a 23rd place finish in a field of 161 runners. The St. Mary's Girls team finished 8th out of 26 teams! Josie Slaven (12:52), Kelsey Slaven (13:23.4), and Caitlyn Kendall (13:23.5) finished in the top 20 out of 145 runners. Josie Slaven earned a medal for her 12th place finish.

We wish these Knights' harriers continued success in the remainder of their season! Come out and see them race at our home course sometime.

We have food crews who cook the meals and prepare them for delivery. And we have delivery drivers each weekend.

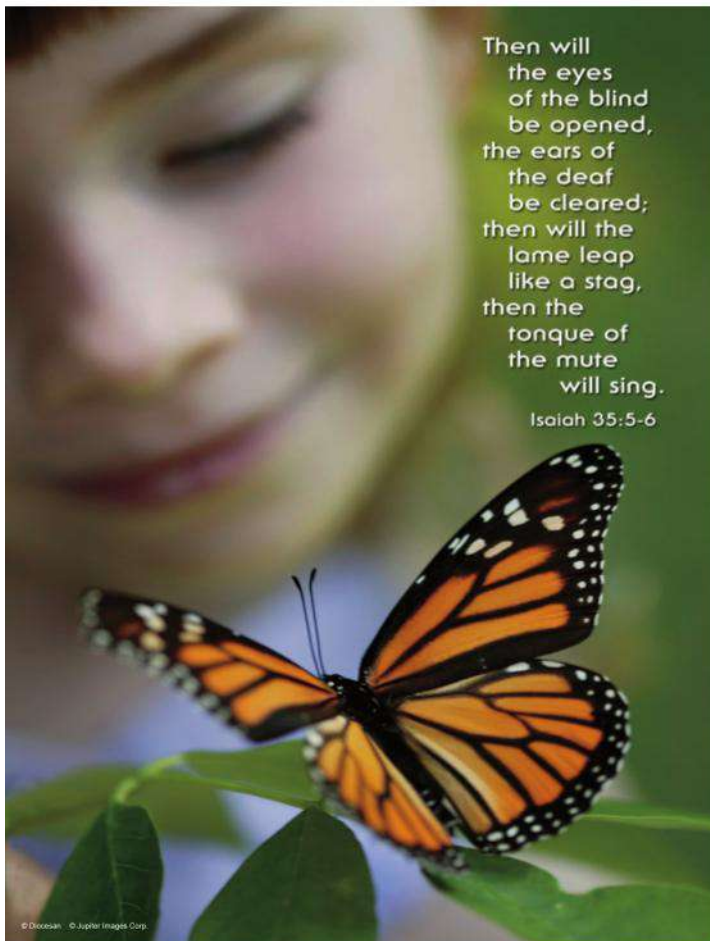
