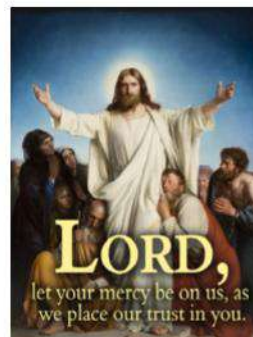

## I LEARN Checkpoints

This year, our school is participating in an exciting new pilot program for the ILEARN Checkpoints, an initiative by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) designed to help students from Grades 3 to 8 in assessing their progress in key skills and concepts in English/Language Arts (ELA) and Math. Over 70% of Indiana schools are piloting the new assessments this year.

ILEARN Checkpoints are short assessments that will be given three times during the school year: Fall, Winter, and Spring. Each checkpoint contains 20-25 questions designed to measure students' understanding of critical skills and concepts as outlined in the Indiana Academic Standards. These checkpoints provide teachers with valuable information to guide instruction and support each student's learning journey. Key Details About the ILEARN Checkpoints:

These checkpoints are an essential component of the new ILEARN through-year assessment that will be fully implemented across Indiana in the 2025-26 school year. By participating in this pilot, our school is at the forefront of adopting this innovative approach to assessing student learning and supporting academic growth. We encourage all families to support their children through this process and to reach out to their child's teacher or the school with any questions or concerns. Our first checkpoint will be this month.

### Did you know?

For the past several years our school has been praying for seminarian Randy Schneider. Now we have adopted a second seminarian – one we know very well. St. Mary's alumnus, Adam Hermes, is studying to become a priest. We have added him to our prayers as we support his journey. What a powerful witness he will be to the current St. Mary's students having walked the same halls! We pray daily for Randy and Adam as they answer the call to the priesthood.

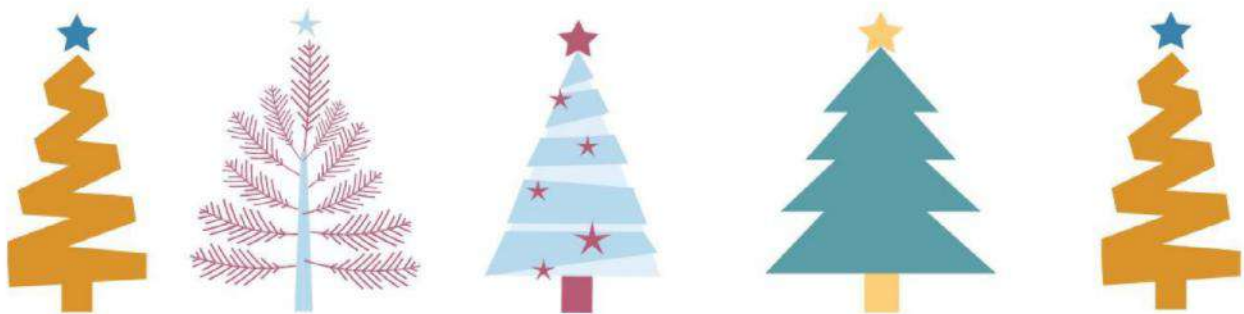
