### All Souls, Cemetery Blessing

### November 2 & 3

Our annual remembrance of those who have passed in the last year will take place at all Masses on November 2 & 3. Following the 10 am Mass, is the Service of Remembrance at the cemetery. We will gather at the Cross at the cemetery for prayers, blessing of the graves, and private visitation. Everyone is invited to this special celebration as we pray together for All Souls.

"Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord. May the perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen."

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. All Saints' Day was formally started by Pope Boniface IV, who consecrated the Parthenon at Rome to the Virgin Mary and all the Martyrs on May 13 in 609 AD. Boniface IV also established All Souls' Day, which follows All



Saints. All Saints Day should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven.

All Soul's Day commemorates all of the faithful departed, and offers us the opportunity to aid the poor souls in purgatory by our prayers and devotions. In fact, an indulgence for the souls in purgatory is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed.

### Wednesday: Double the Fun: Drug Free is the Way!


Students will dress like a friend or friends and talk about how being a good friend means helping your friends make good choices.
