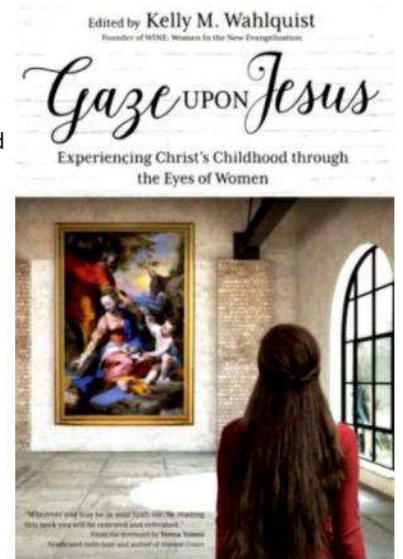

- New collection counters needed. Andy to look at possible replacements.
- Principal Nancy Buening presented information on the current salary structure for the teachers at St. Mary's. Our teachers currently lag behind the local public schools systems. Nancy is working on a proposal to try to narrow the gap, which should help in teacher retention.
