Candlemas Day is another name for the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple for the rites of purification and dedication as prescribed by the Torah. So the Presentation is a proclamation of Christ — Messiah and Priest, Lord and Savior. He is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, traditionally at least since the seventh century, candles have been blessed and available at Mass this day that can be used throughout the year, hence coining the term "Candlemas."





St. Mary's School, in partnership with the family and church, provides a Christ-centered education in the Catholic tradition by nurturing the development of each child, in order to reach his/her full potential.

Dear Families,

It has been our tradition in past years to conduct a special Open House for prospective kindergarten students. We are happy to announce that this year we will be hosting the **Open House on Monday**, **January 20**, **2025**. Since this is the Martin Luther King Day holiday, there will be no school for students on that day unless it is needed to make up a snow day. The kindergarten teachers, Mrs. Jenny Smith and Mrs. Emily Weigel, will be in their classrooms **during the hours of 3:00 to 6:00 PM** to meet you and your child, allow you to see the classrooms, and answer any questions that you may have about St. Mary's kindergarten.

The St. Mary's kindergarten program is a full-day program that involves a hands-on approach in a Christ-centered environment. We follow the State standards for instruction, and we infuse our Catholic faith into every part of our school day. Knowing that young children learn best by practicing skills in a variety of ways, we use a myriad of approaches to learning from the traditional paper-pencil tasks to hands-on activities to technology-based lessons. We even use play as a way to let children discover ideas on their own while building social skills.

Kindergarten registration will take place during the first weeks of March.

Registration typically takes place online. Families who currently have older students in our school will simply add the kindergarten student to the forms that are submitted for the rest of their children. Parents who are enrolling their first child in K-8 will need to contact the school office (812-663-2804) for registration information if you do not receive information via mail. It will be very important to submit the registration forms by the registration deadline in order to hold a spot in the kindergarten class for your child. There is a maximum number of students that we can allow in the kindergarten class to ensure the best learning environment.

We hope that you and your child will be able to attend our Open House on Monday, January 20, anytime from 3:00 to 6:00 PM. You will be able to learn more about our program to help you make an informed decision about your child's kindergarten experience. Students who are eligible for the 2025-2026 kindergarten class must be 5 years of age by August 1, 2025. 


