

Minutes of Parish Council Meeting Held 2-18-2025

Finance

- 1) December net income \$16,028. Year to date through December, with voucher payments, is \$418,438
- 2) The company that handles the EFT (electronic funds transfer) has been bought out. There is a learning curve with the new system.

- 1) The first steering meeting of the Young Adult Committee (YAC) was an engaging success. They are brainstorming ideas and planning for their March meeting.
- 2) Starting a list of possible names for the upcoming Parish elections
- 3) Forming surveys to gather data on key issue initiatives to aid in future planning.
- 4) Vocations awareness committee meeting in March to designate a panel.

Liturgy

- 1) Liturgy committee is meeting 2/19 to plan Masses and services through Easter. There is an App which allows music ministers to listen to all of the planned songs.
- 2) The servers enjoyed a snow tubing day with Fr. John at Perfect North slopes. Over 30 families attended.
- 3) There will be a meeting scheduled with the Eucharistic ministers.

Youth Ministry

- 1) 33 students signed up for Confirmation. Several parishes will be combining for the event. There will be two Masses held to accommodate all of the candidates.
- 2) Vacation Bible School will start planning after Spring Break
- 3) Religious Ed Mass will be on 4/9

School

- 1) Pre-school registration going well, three of four classes are full.
- 2) Two new students enrolled in January one 1st grade and one 2nd grade. 2nd grade now at capacity.
- 3) ILEARN Checkpoint #2 has started
- 4) Working on Mental Health grant from Community Foundation to get extra days paid for the social worker
- 5) St Mary's Archery Team has qualified for State
- 6) Working on retention ideas for coaches

Maintenance

- 1) Main focus has been the replacement/repair of the chiller system. Total quoted costs will be just under \$19,500.
- 2) Snow removal was handled well, thanks to the team.




