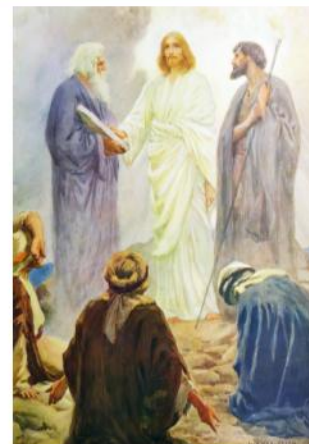

Academic Meet

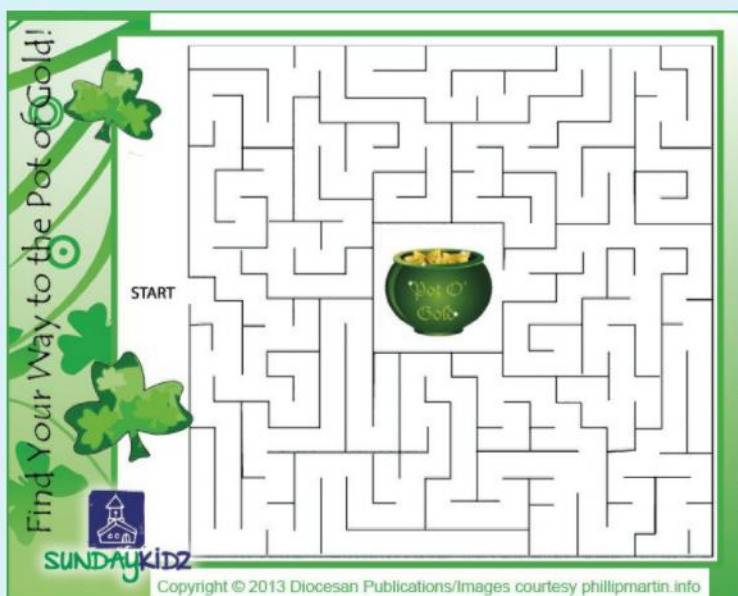

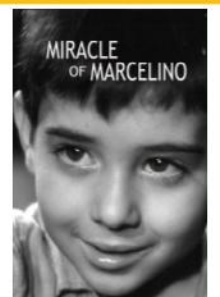
