

## River the Dog

On Friday, March 14, the students at St. Mary School got the privilege of meeting River the Dog. River was rescued from the streets of Dallas, TX and fostered by a family who noticed an issue with River's eyes. The vet found many infections in his eyes and so had to remove them both to save the dog's life. After the surgery, River met his forever-owners, Bethany VanMeter and her husband, who moved him to his forever home in Tennessee.

Bethany has written three books about this special dog and his many abilities. The first was, I See with My Heart, about River's disability.

She read this book to the students and mixed in more background information about River and the many things that he can still do despite being totally blind. The students got to see him fetch and go up and down the steps in the bleachers, all by using his other senses.

The second book was, <u>I Got a Cat for Christmas</u>. This focused on River's unlikely friendship with his cat, Tiger. The lasting message to students was that being different is OK. The third book, <u>River has a Purpose and So Do You</u>, talks about the fact that we can do hard things. But the overarching lesson was to be Boldly Kind. Bethany encouraged students to step out of their comfort zone and befriend those who are different and that the first step is to just be kind.

At the end of the presentation students were invited to pet River if they felt comfortable. Our students could not wait to meet the star of the show! And each classroom received a copy of all three books so that we can always remember this special dog.

## Notice from the Cemetery

Please be advised that the mowing season is near and any objects not in accordance with cemetery rules and regulations need to be removed as soon as possible. This includes any object (statue, bench, plaque) resting on the grass. A shepherd's hook is permitted. We will start seeding the ground on the newly buried when the dirt has settled and weather permits.

Please help keep our cemetery a tranquil and clean place for all to visit and pray.

## St. Mary Cemetery Rules Regulations

**Foundations and Monuments:** 

No iron, wire work, seat, benched, vases, or lawn ornaments will be allowed upon the lots. A shepherd's hook is permitted. Non-rust vases mounted to a monument will be permitted.

### Flowers-Trees-Shrubbery

Flowers, trees, and shrubbery may not be planted around the headstone or on the grave. Cut flowers and other decorations may be placed on the graves up to a limit of four bouquets. However, from April 1st to October 30th of each year, flowers and decorations must remain on the headstones or a shepherd's hook.

The cemetery custodians, parish priest, or parish council reserves the right to remove any of the above mentioned, which they consider injurious to the appearance of the cemetery.

Beginning April 1st, any items deemed not in accordance with these rules will be removed and stored by the cemetery maintenance staff for no longer than 30 days. Please contact the parish office 812-663-8427 with any questions.
