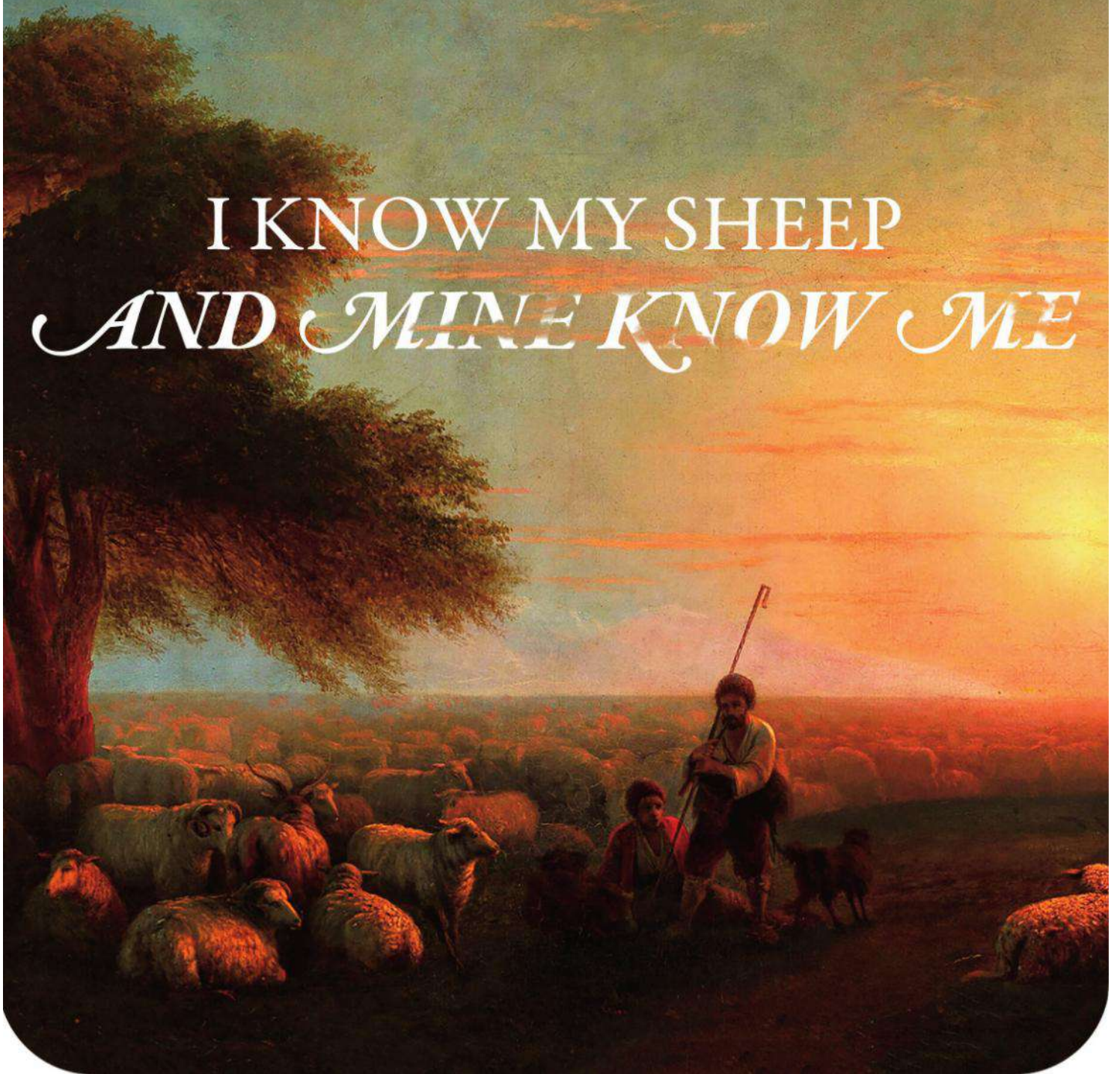

Mrs. Buening explained the Divine Mercy Image and taught the students how to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet.



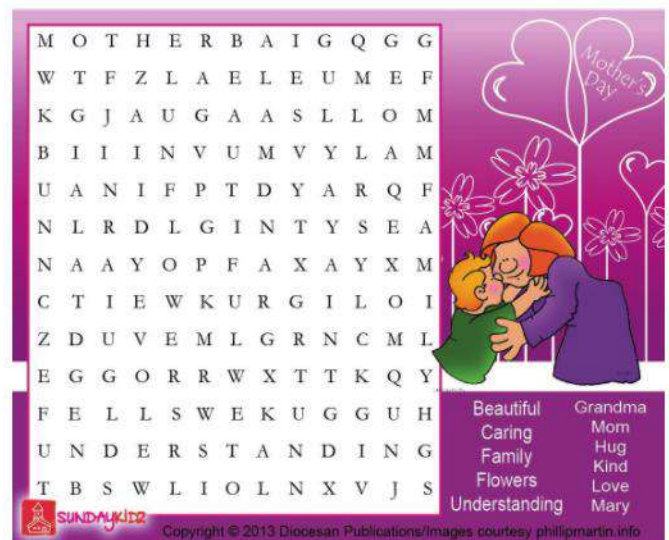
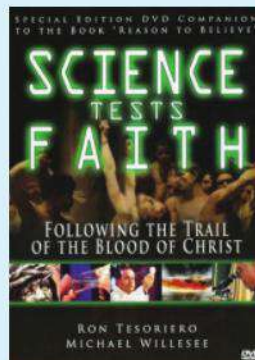

We will be staying with a local family who is very well known in the community, and we are fundraising to be able to purchase a variety of medical, farming, and school supplies. All the donations raised will be going toward the Toto Asio Nursery & Primary School, the Ngora Health Center, and the local farmers of Ngora, Uganda. Every little bit counts! 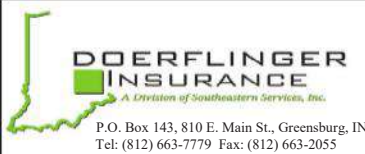
