

# **Holy Trinity Sunday**

The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity is a celebration of the central mystery of the Christian faith—that God is one in essence but three in Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. While the Trinity is present throughout the liturgical year, this feast is set aside to contemplate and adore this profound truth.

On this day, Catholics: Worship the Triune God, acknowledging the divine nature of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Reflect on the mystery of the Trinity, the foundation of Christian doctrine. Recognize the presence of the Trinity in their daily lives, through prayer, the sacraments, and acts of love. Renew their Baptismal promises, recalling that they were baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This solemnity invites the faithful to enter more deeply into the mystery of God, even though the Trinity surpasses human understanding.

#### Theological Significance


The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the most profound doctrine of the Christian faith: One God in Three Persons – The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not three gods, but one God in three divine Persons.

The Relationship of Love – The Trinity is a communion of love, eternally united in self-giving.

God's Presence in Our Lives – The Father creates, the Son redeems, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies.

The Foundation of the Sacraments – Baptism, the Eucharist, and all sacraments are administered in the name of the Trinity.

The Trinity is not just a theological idea—it is the very nature of God and the basis of Christian life.

#### A Minute in the Church Book Series





# Adopt A Village- Hearts for Honduras

Dear St. Mary's Parish Family,

On two weekends in May, you poured out true Christian love from your hearts and souls. It was overwhelming to see your show of love and affection for the poorest of the poor people in Cucuyagua, Honduras with your gifts to these children of God. Your treasured items like baby clothes or items passed down to you from family showed the true spirit of giving that is a part of this awesome parish. Your generosity has been beyond anything ever imagined.

All of this is in addition to \$1 million dollars to help build a community center (named St. Mary's), 53 houses, a school and the professional psychological and social support to teach them to live as a community with clean water, flushing toilets, and electricity. Each will learn a marketable skill to sustain them and their families, and they will learn to lean on each other instead of competing for sparse resources. This community model has proved to be successful throughout the country by a CEPUDO/Food for the Poor partnership to aid this second poorest country in Latin America.

YOU (beautiful hearts and souls of St. Mary's) truly have changed their lives forever. When we first visited in 2023, we met families that had not eaten and did not know where their next meal was coming from. You have given "the shirt off your back" for those in dire need. I have been a part of this parish all my life and I am amazed at your awesomeness. May God bless you!

I also want to make you aware that Batesville Tool and Die provided the trucking free to Food for the Poor in Florida where it will be loaded on a container for ocean shipment to CEPUDO in Honduras. Decatur County Memorial Hospital provided rehabilitation equipment that these people may have never had access to. St. Vincent de Paul in Indianapolis provided a "bale" of shirts and 40+ bicycles with a skid of bicycle parts. Along with that YOU provided the rest of the "load of love" and all the little things that might be needed to fill these new homes with warmth and a bond that we all take for granted. We had trouble getting everything in, the trailer was so full! With all the bicycles that were included (77) each family will have one or two for transportation to minimize the travel time to work or to the larger towns. I especially want to thank Fr. Carlton Beever whose encouragement brought on our awareness of Honduras. Thank you to all those who were moved to help with loading and reloading the trailer.

I also want to encourage you to continue to pray for the continuation of help for Honduras. Please consider visiting the Dedication on October 6 – 10th this fall. Call me at 812-614-3341. I will return your call. May the Peace of God be with you all, Sincerely,




