Open House

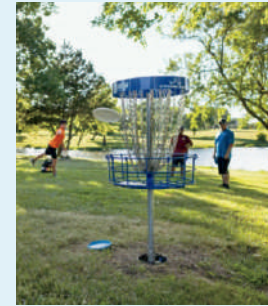

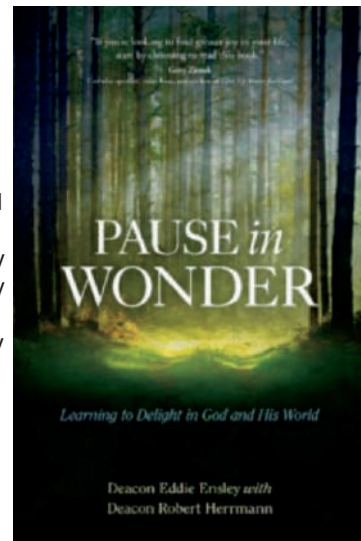
