

#### What is NCYC?

The National Catholic Youth Conference is a three-day event of prayer, community, service, and catechesis for high-school-aged Catholics and their chaperones. It is the largest Catholic youth event in the United States.

#### Where and when is it held?

The event takes place at the Indiana Convention Center and Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis. For 2025, the dates are November 20–22. What happens at NCYC?

The conference features nationally recognized Catholic speakers, artists, and liturgies. It also includes an interactive exhibit hall with service, artistic, and educational opportunities, plus various workshops and activities.

#### How much does it cost to attend?

It is approximately \$750 per student to attend. This includes conference pass, lodging, and meals. In the past, St. Mary has been able to fund up to 100% with fundraisers and donations. Any remaining money needed, after fundraising, will be due by March of 2026.

#### Will students be excused for missing school?

NCYC will provide an excuse letter. Each student should communicate with their school prior to the conference to get approval.

#### What do past participants say about attending NCYC?

Many say it is life changing! Teens speak of being moved during powerful talks, adoration, and Mass, leading to a closer connection with Christ. Not only that, it is fun and energizing to be united with thousands of Catholic youth!


