



# Saint Jude: Saint of the Impossible

Our Lord appeared to both Saint Bridget of Sweden and Saint Bernard, asking them to accept Saint Jude as the "Patron Saint of the Impossible." Jesus told Saint Brigid of Sweden:

"In accordance with his surname (last name), Thaddeus, the amiable or loving, he will show himself most willing to give help."

Throughout his life, Jude preached the Gospel passionately even when it was very difficult. He traveled throughout Mesopotamia, Lybia, and Persia with Saint Simon the Zealot. It is believed that both Simon and Jude were martyred in either Persia or Armenia.


Saint Jude is the Patron Saint of hopeless, lost, desperate, and impossible causes. Legend has it that many people did not pray for his intercession because they were afraid of accidentally praying to Judas Iscariot. It is believed that Saint Jude was so eager to assist anyone who prayed to him that he interceded in the most impossible situations. He is usually depicted holding a club and the image of Jesus in his hands. He is also pictured with a flame on his head, which is a symbol of Pentecost. The Feast of Saint Jude (and Saint Simon) is celebrated on October 28.


