# Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

Monday, December 8

Patronal feast day of the United States of America. On December 8, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. \* (This feast is a holy day of obligation for dioceses in the United States.) On this feast, we celebrate Mary's conception free from the stain of Original Sin, and we recognize that Mary's life began

the moment she was conceived in the womb of St. Anne. So, too, does every human life begin at the moment of fertilization: "You formed my inmost being; you knit me in my womb" (Ps 139:13). The Immaculate Conception is sometimes confused with the Annunciation. On this solemnity, consider praying Pope Francis' Prayer for the Immaculate Conception: "We are in need of your immaculate gaze, to rediscover the ability to look upon persons and things with respect and awareness."

We offer a school Mass at 8:15 am and an evening Mass at 5:30 pm on Monday, December 8.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Retirement Fund for Religious was established in 1988 to help religious communities provide for senior members' current and future retirement and healthcare needs. Ninety-five percent of the proceeds are distributed to support the direct care of our aging sisters, brothers, and religious order priests. In 2023 parishioners from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis contributed approximately \$236,154.00 to the collection. Because of your generosity and that of donors from across the United States, the Benedictine Monks of St. Meinrad, the Conventual Franciscan Friars of Mount St. Francis, the Sisters of Providence of St. Mary-of-the-Woods, and the Sisters of St. Francis in Oldenburg received a combined total of over \$2,018,664.00 in financial support.

The annual collection for 2025 will take place in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis,

December 13 - 14, 2025. The escalating costs of prescriptions and healthcare make this
collection an important source of funding for religious communities. Out of gratitude for their
lives of dedication and service, I urge you to be as generous as you can to ensure the care of our
sisters, brothers, and religious order priests.
