

Each year the Lenten season calls us to grow a little more in our faith as we take a long careful look at ourselves and “scrutinize” our words and actions. The Church gives us three disciplines to help us along the way - PRAYER - FASTING - ALMSGIVING. Lent also prepares us for our celebration of Easter, as we walk, together, with our OCIA group preparing for their baptisms by recalling our own baptism and how we are living our baptismal promises each day. As we begin our Lenten observance, we will ask the Holy Spirit to help us see every person as a Child of God and the grace to see the “Body of Christ” in one another.

We offer several ways to increase your prayer time this Lent. Lenten “Word Among Us” booklets will be available on the kiosks. The Stations of the Cross will be prayed every Friday evening, beginning at 7:00 PM, along with a Communion Service. If your family or someone in your family would like to carry the Cross as we journey to each Station, please call the Parish Office. Other opportunities will be provided for our Lenten observance through our liturgies, prayer, and song. **Our Communal Lenten Penance Service will be held Tuesday, February 24th at 7:00 PM.**

Symphony in Color

St. Mary's students in grade 1-6 participated in the Symphony in Color contest sponsored by the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra in cooperation with the Hilbert Circle Theatre and the Indiana State Museum. Approximately 8,313 students from thirteen counties across the state listened to selected symphonic pieces and then illustrated their interpretations in varied media. 

The Color Purple:

Ash Wednesday:

Ashes are placed on the forehead in the shape of a cross to say "I'm sorry" to God and "I want to follow you"

The Three Pillars of Lent

Prayer:

Talking and listening to God more, perhaps through daily prayer or attending Mass

Fasting (Giving Up):

Giving up things that take our focus away from God like sweets or video games) to help us remember our need for Him.

Almsgiving (Giving To):

Being kind and generous, helping those in need, or sharing with others.
